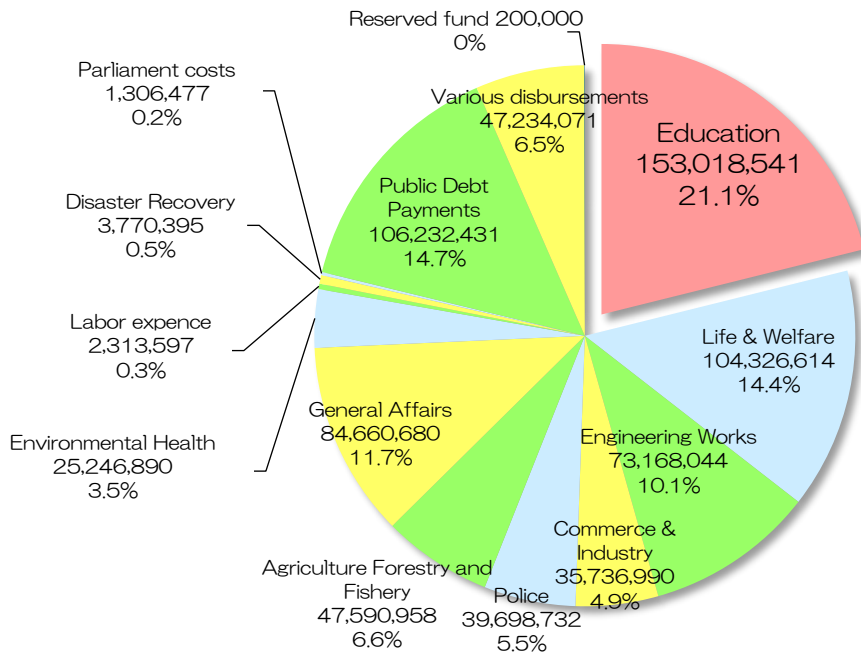

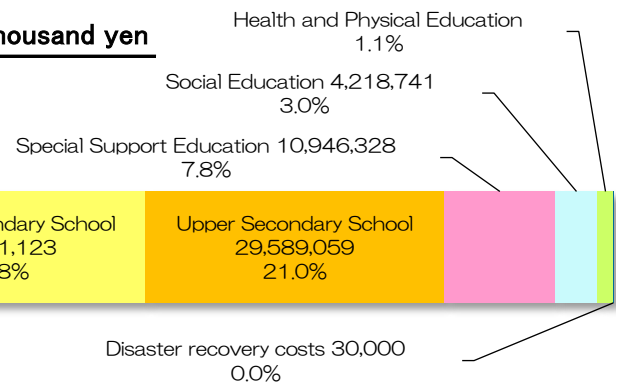

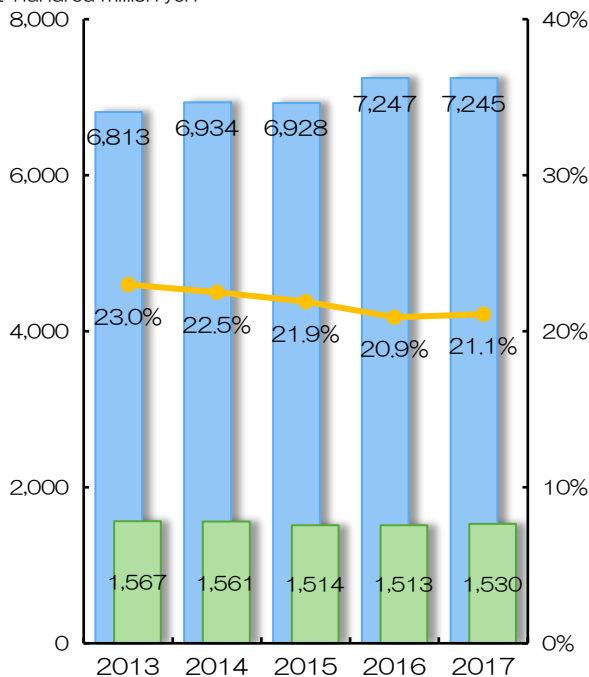

Unit: hundred million yen



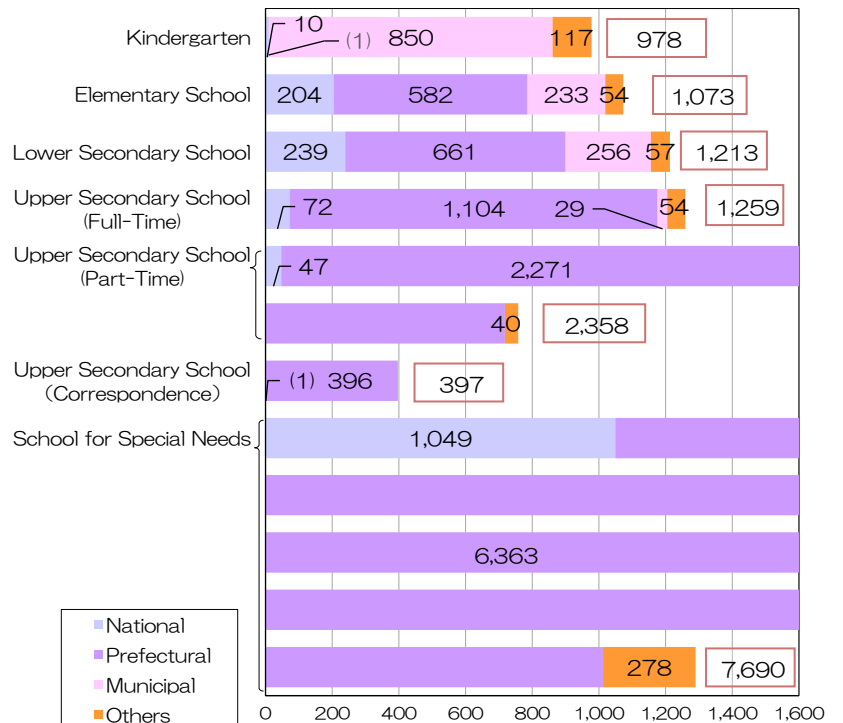

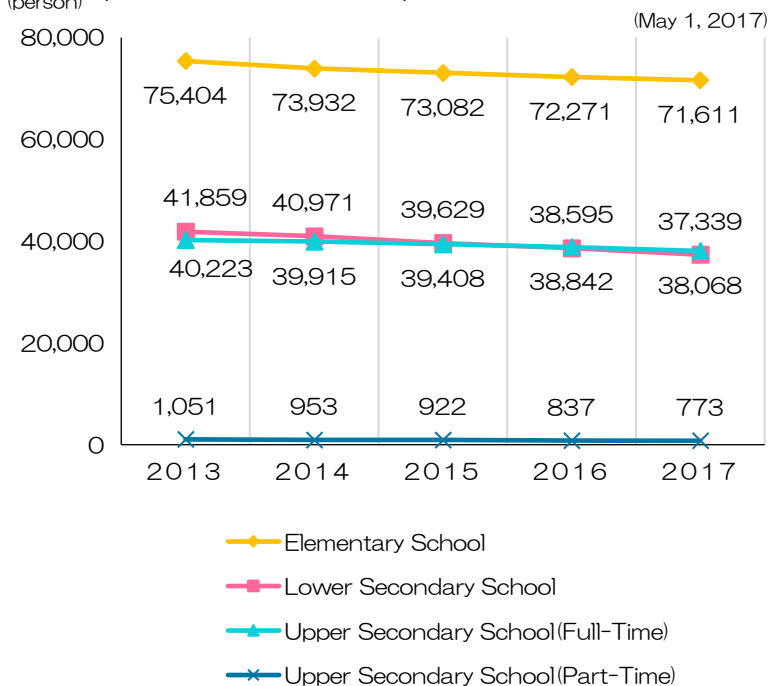

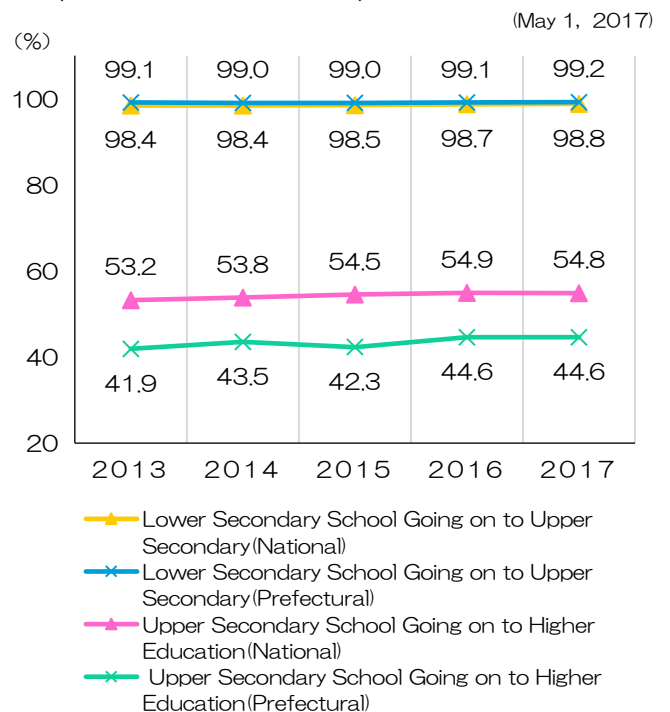

Changes in the Number of Students (National·Public·Private)



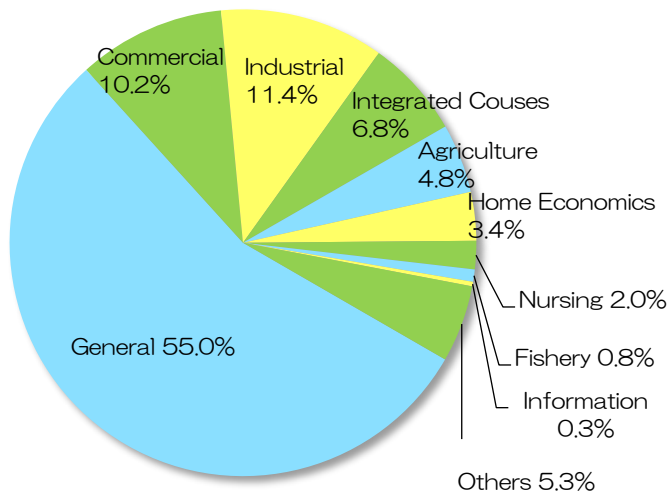
Changes of Enrollment Rate (National·Public·Private)

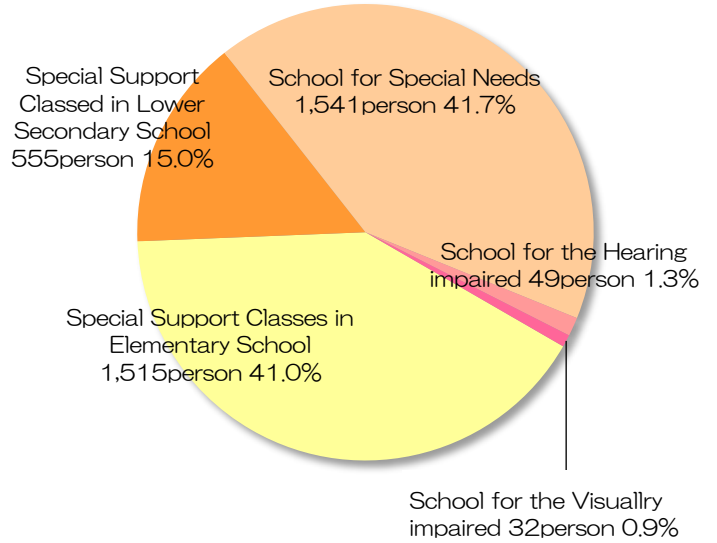

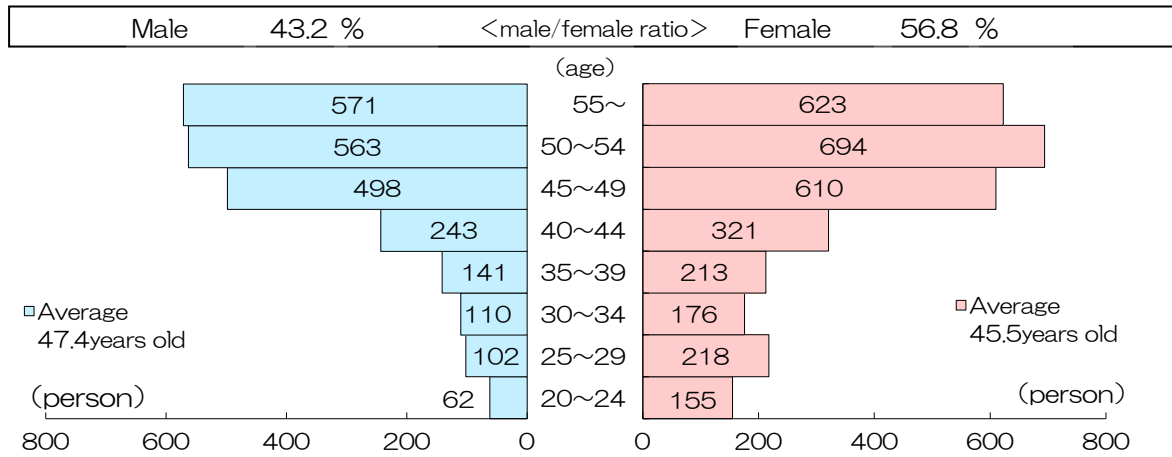

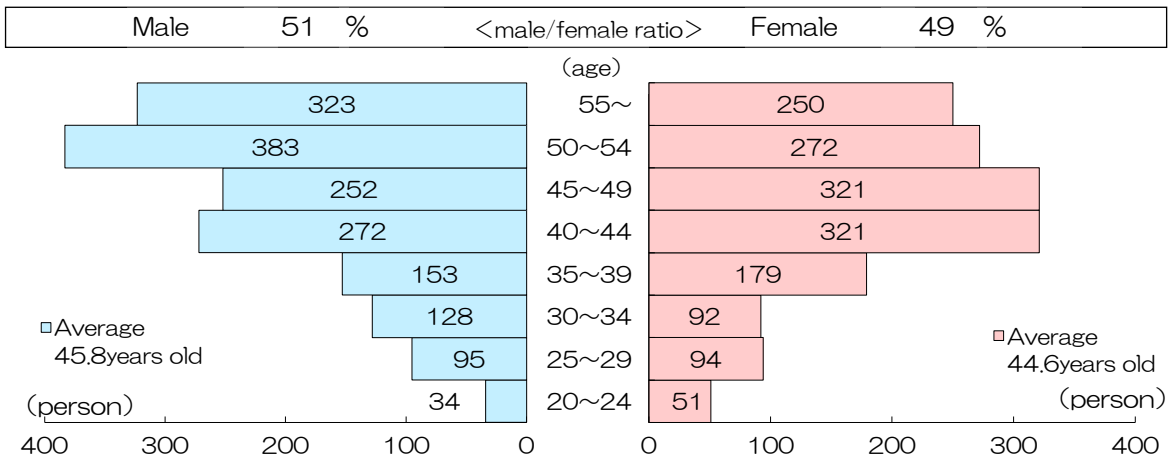
Number of Teachers, by Age

(May 1, 2017)

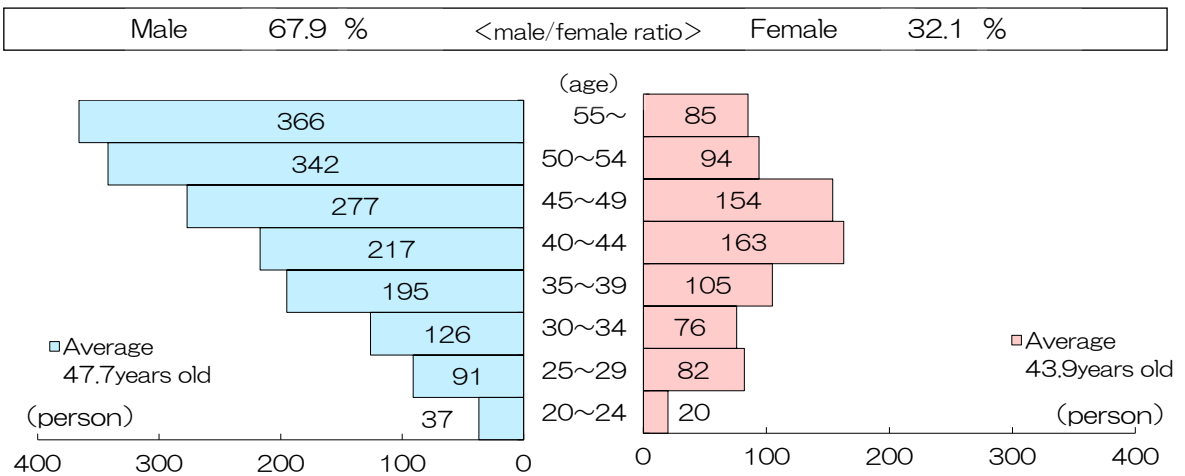

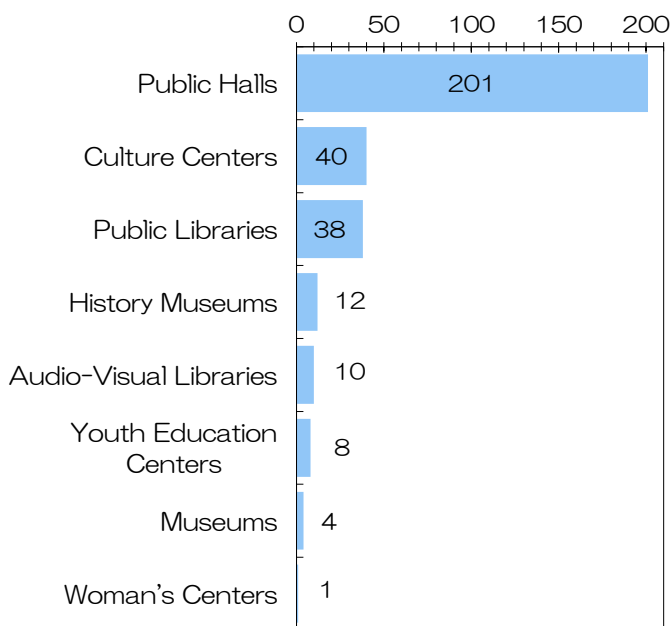

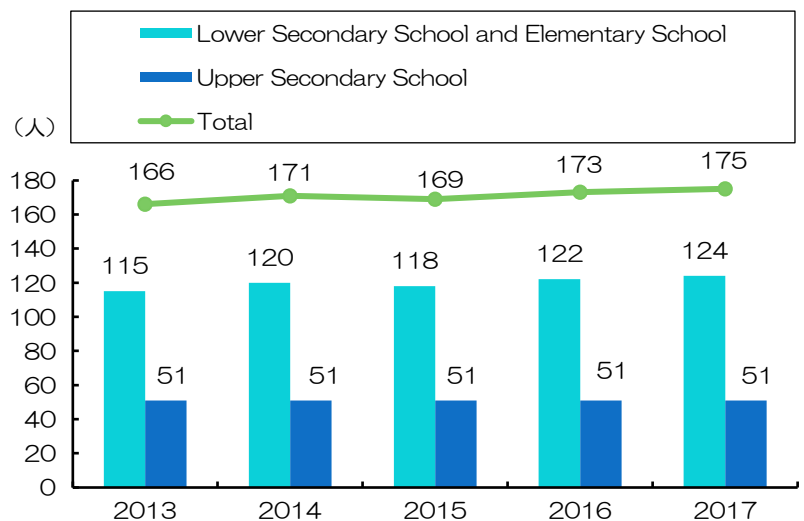

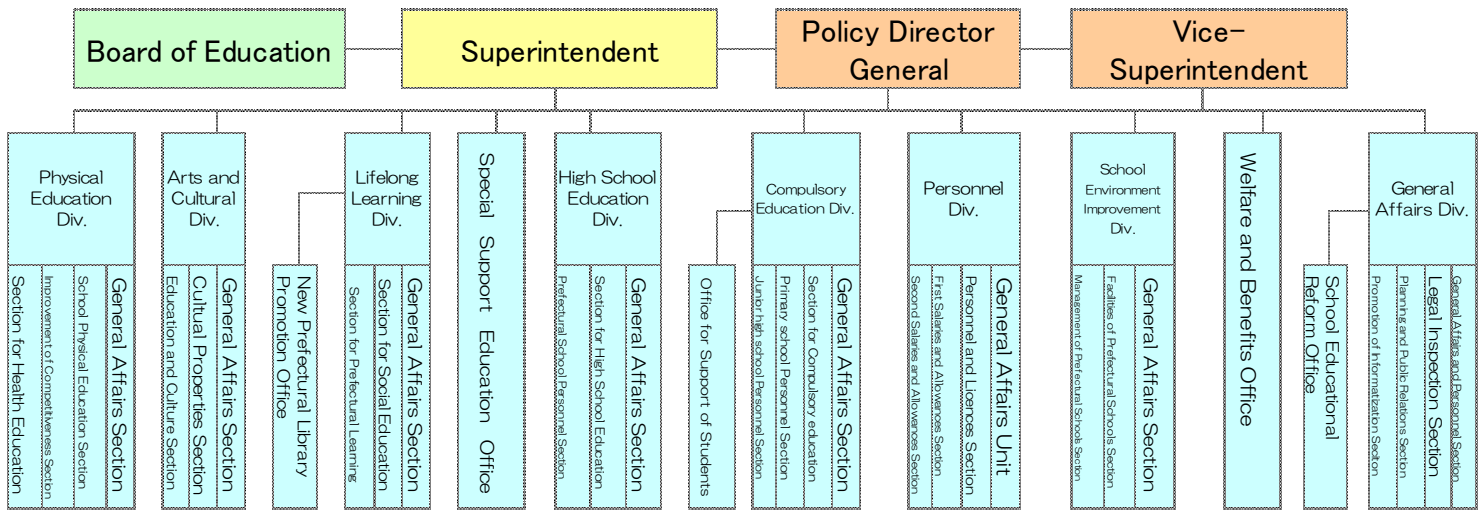

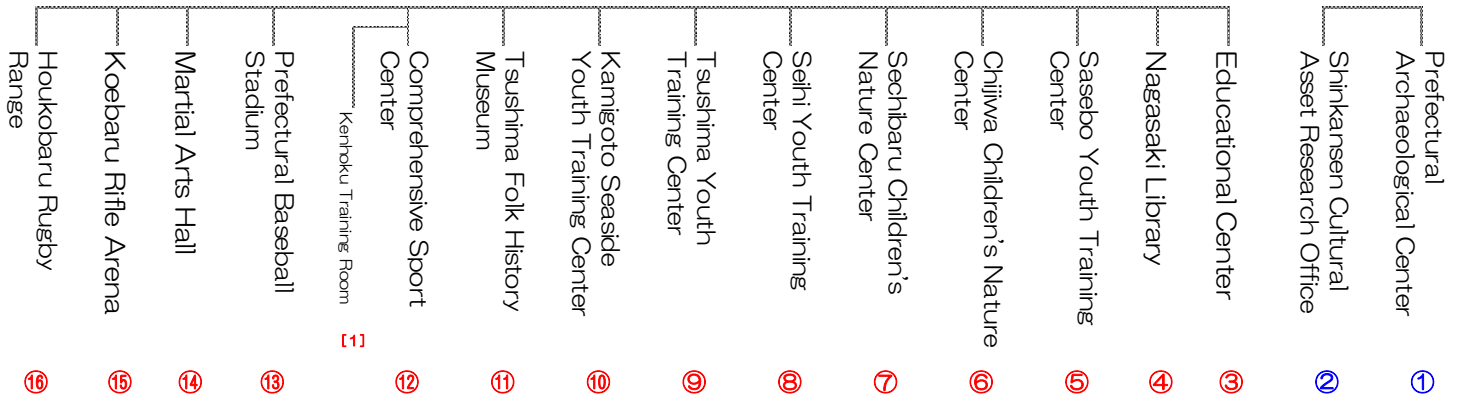
