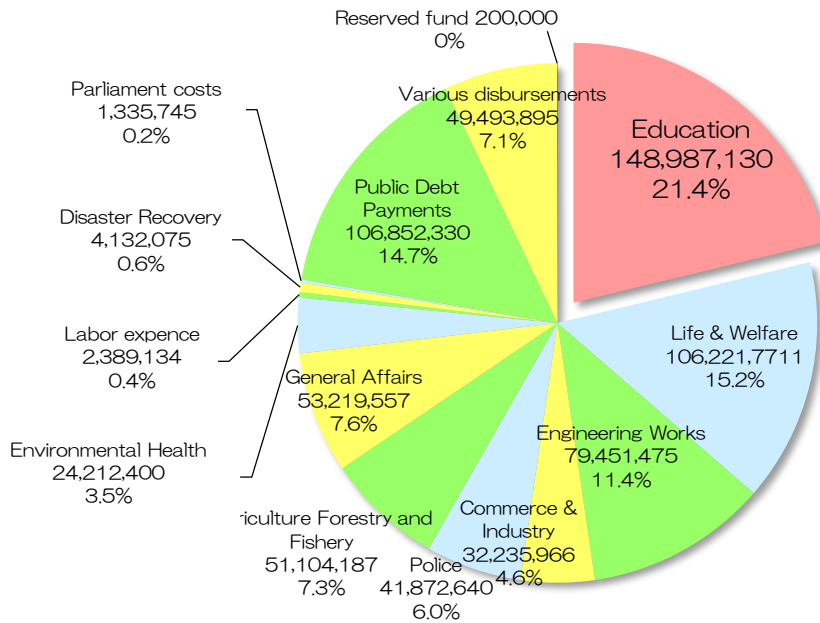

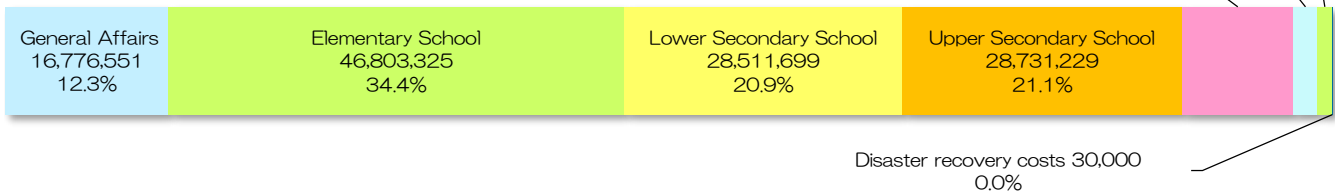

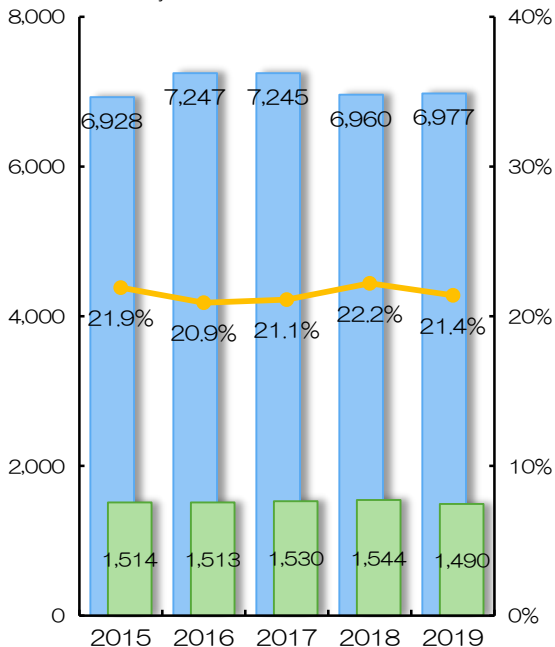

Unit: hundred million yen



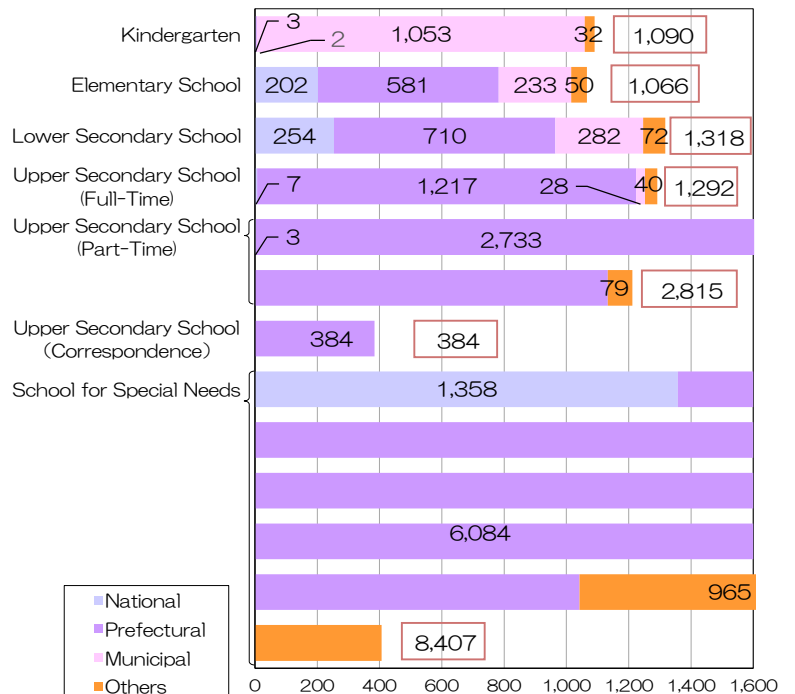
Legend: Total Budget (Blue bar), Educational Expenditure (Green bar), Percentage of Educational Expenditure (Yellow line)

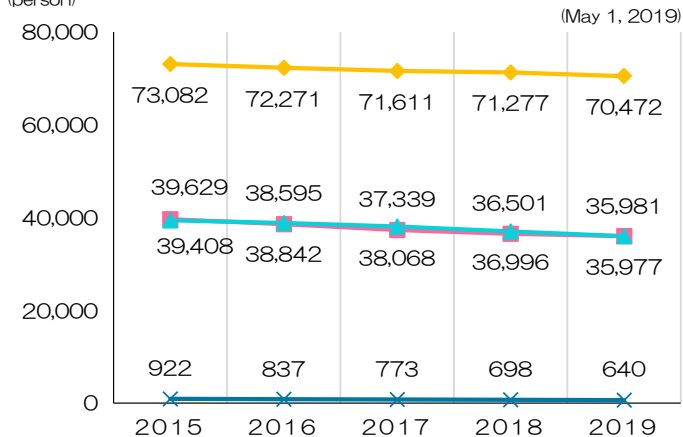

Changes in the Number of Students

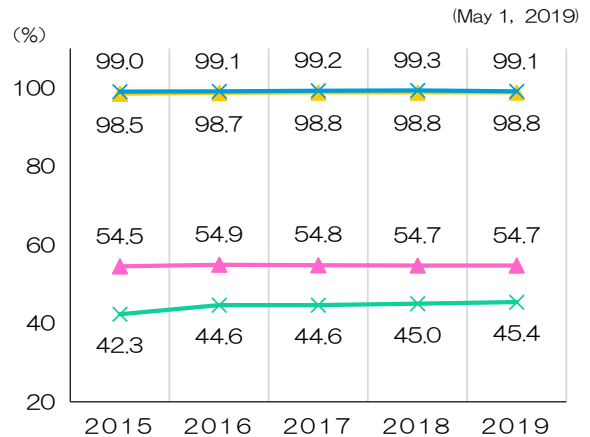

Changes of Enrollment Rate

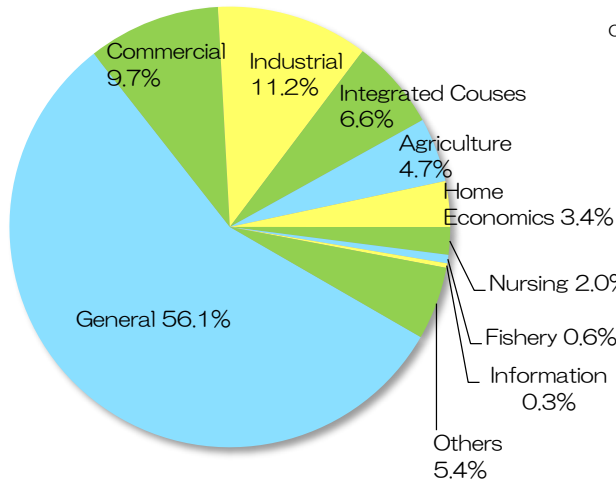

× Upper Secondary School Going on to Higher Education (Prefectural)

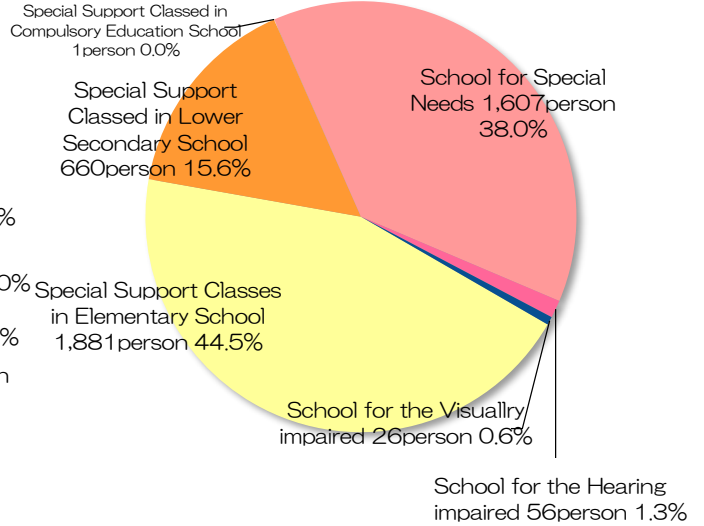
Distribution of Upper Secondary School Students

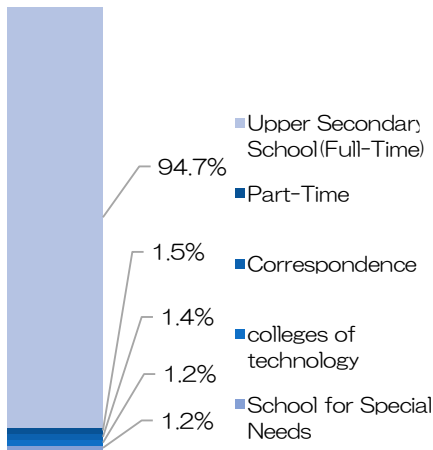

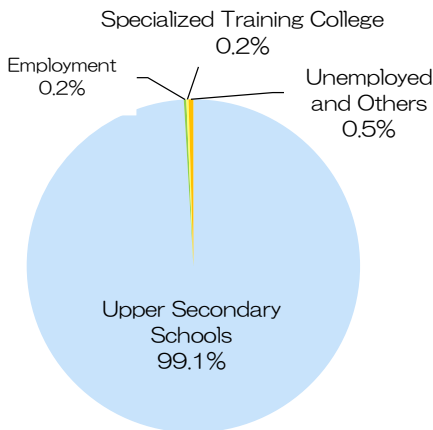


Destinations of Graduates (National•Public•Private)

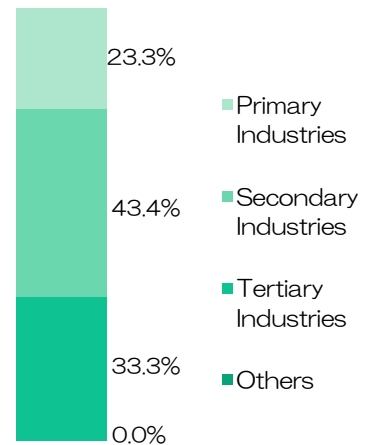

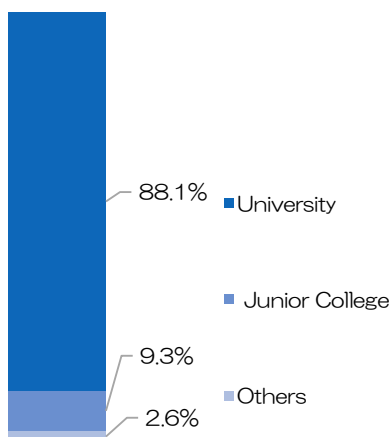

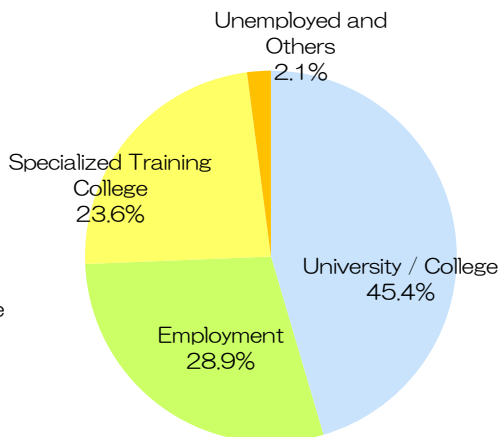

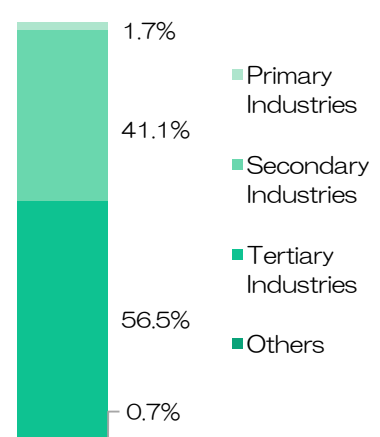

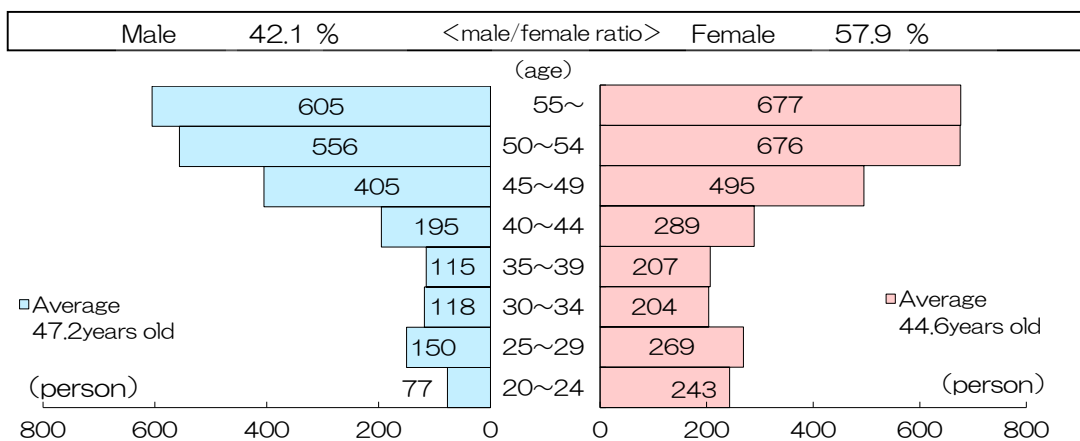

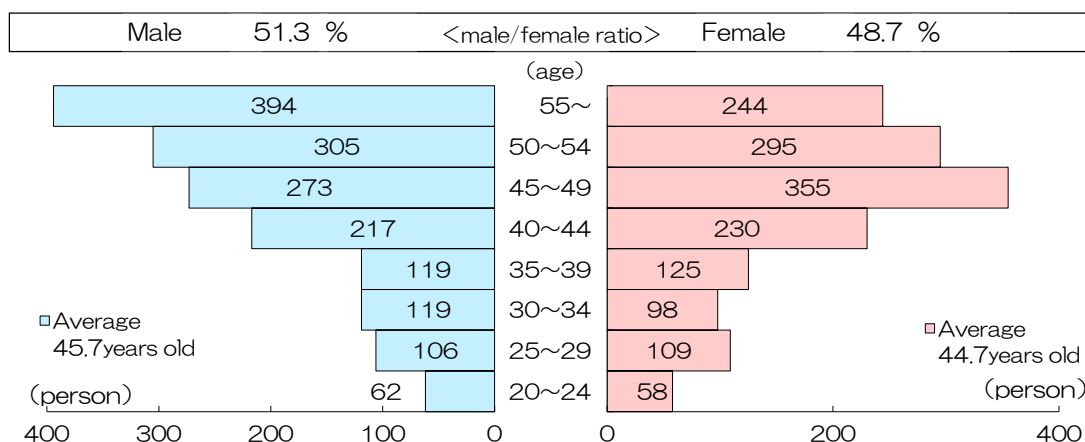
Number of Teachers, by Age

(May 1, 2019)

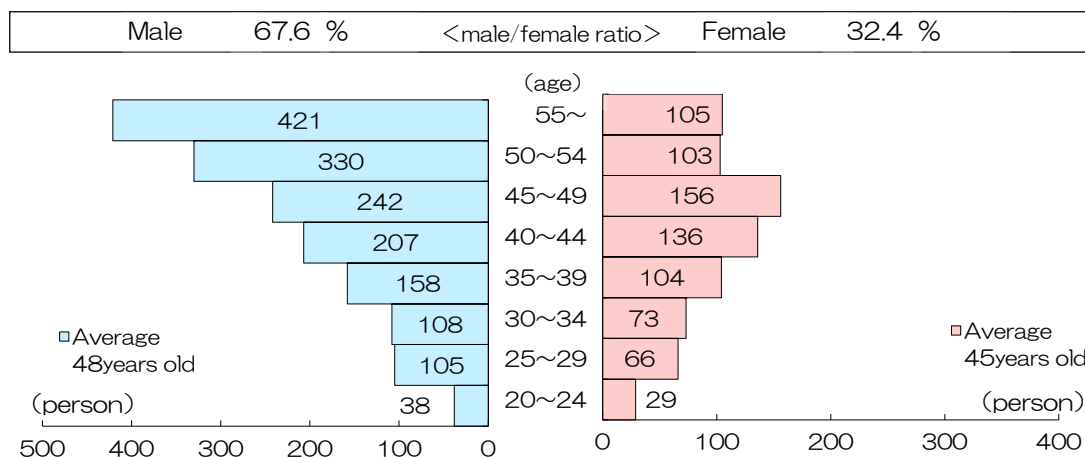
□ Elementary School

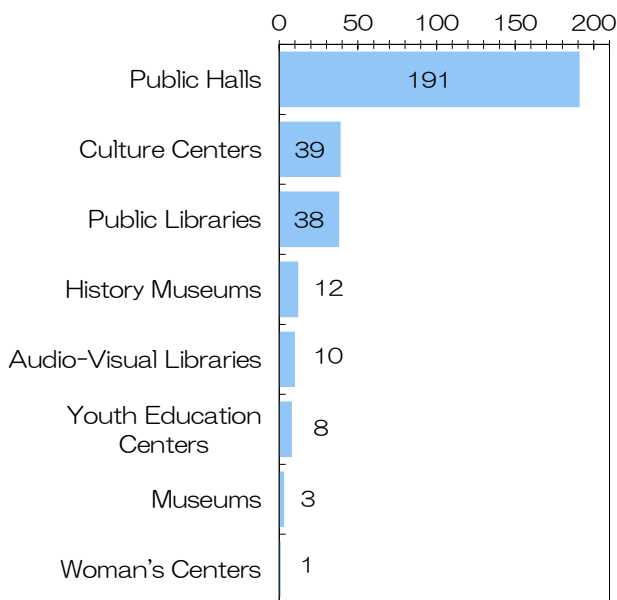

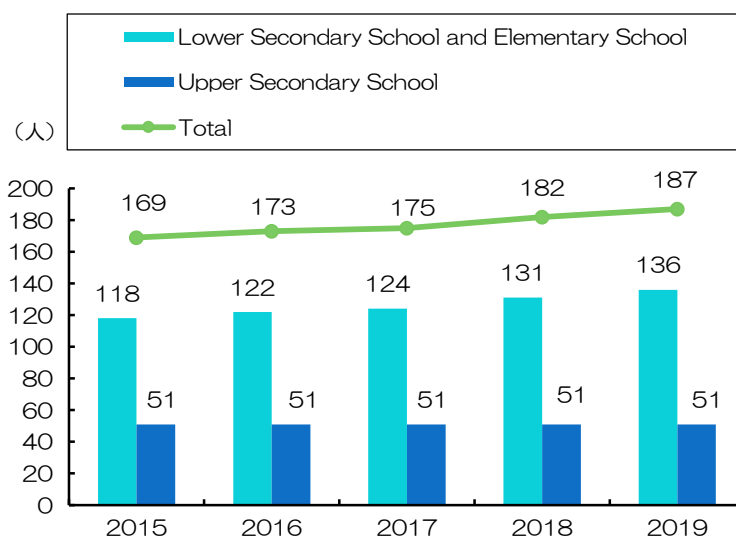

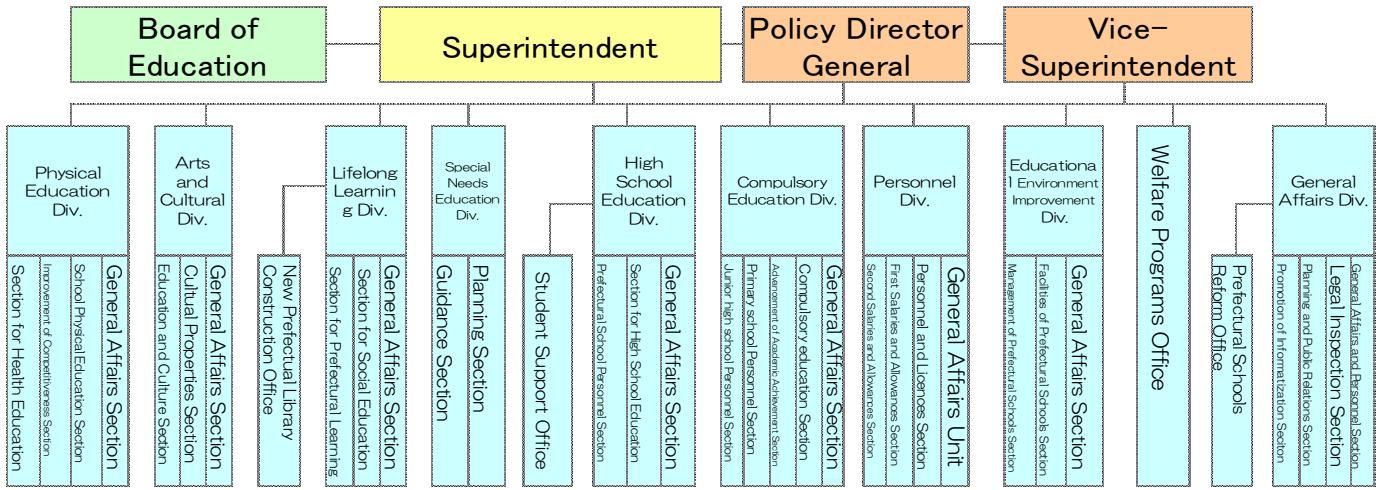
