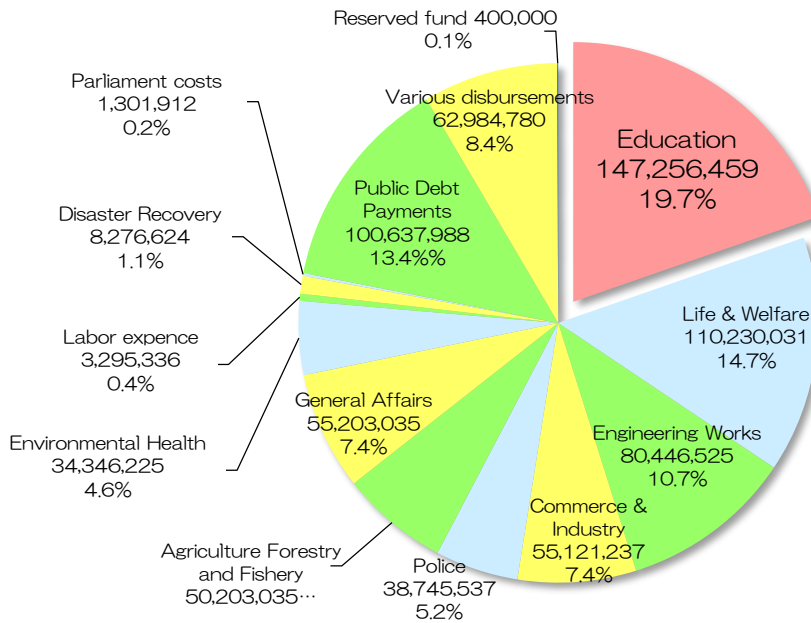

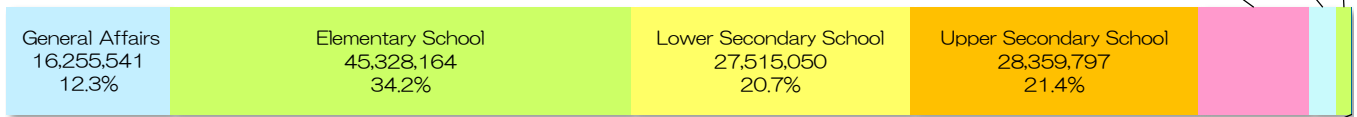

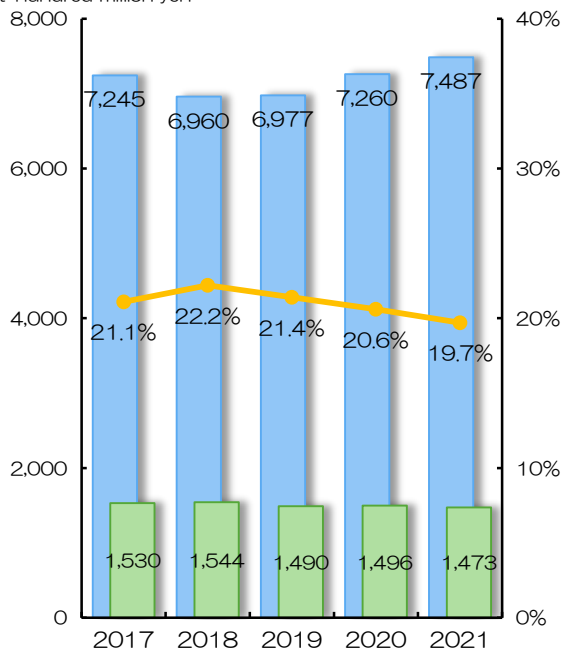

Unit: hundred million yen

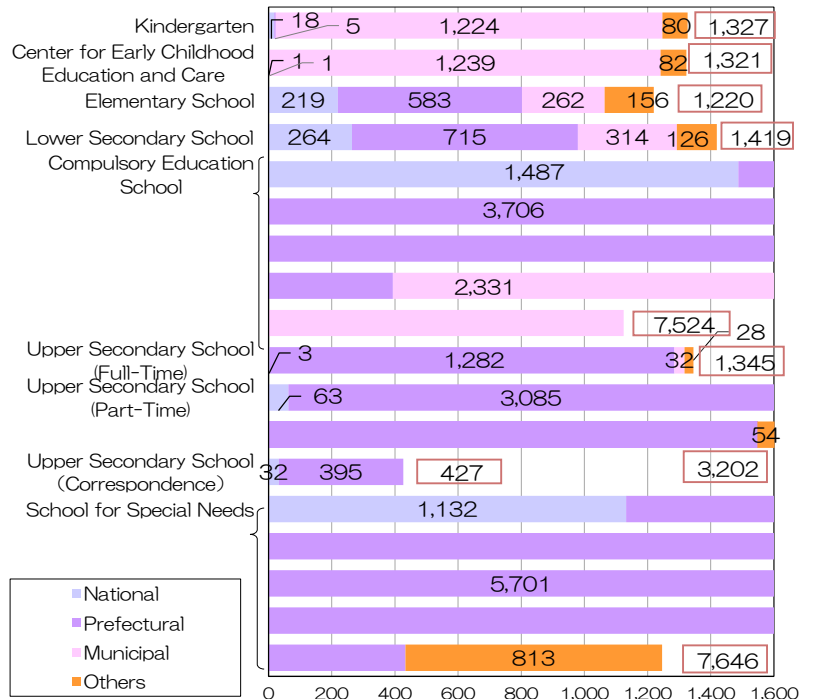


Educational Expenditure Per Student

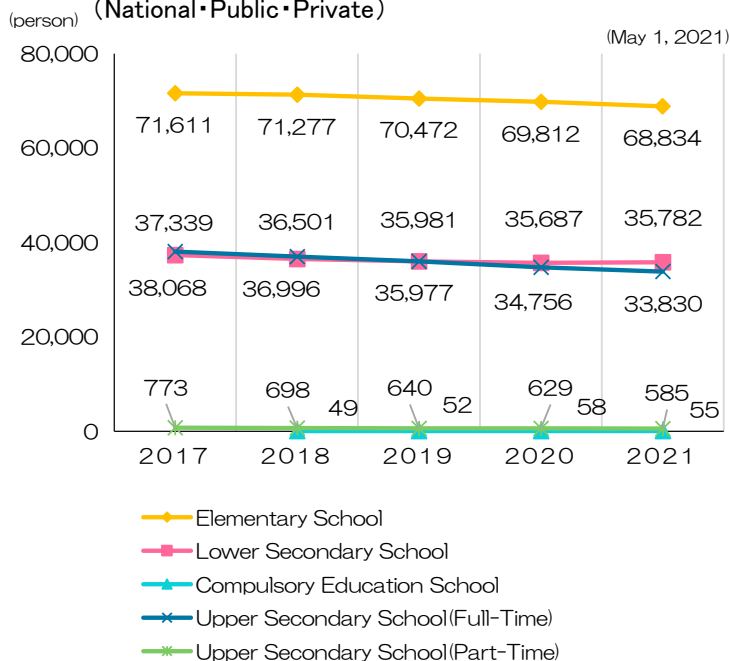

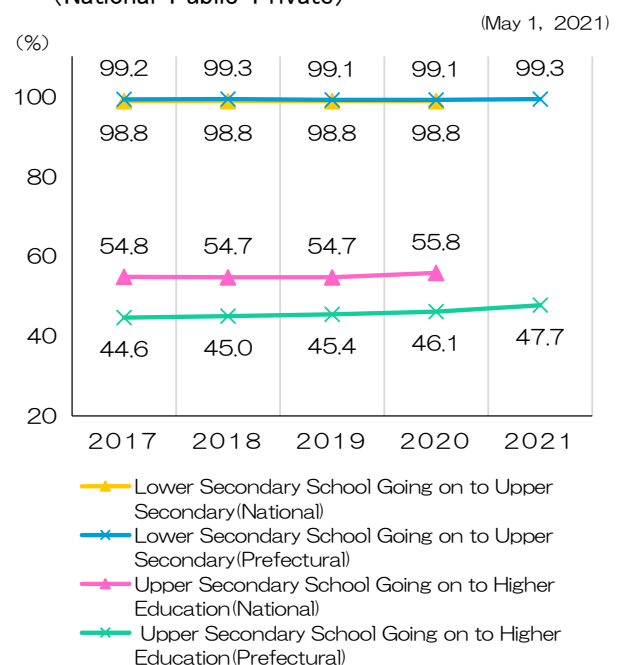

Changes in the Number of Students (National·Public·Private)



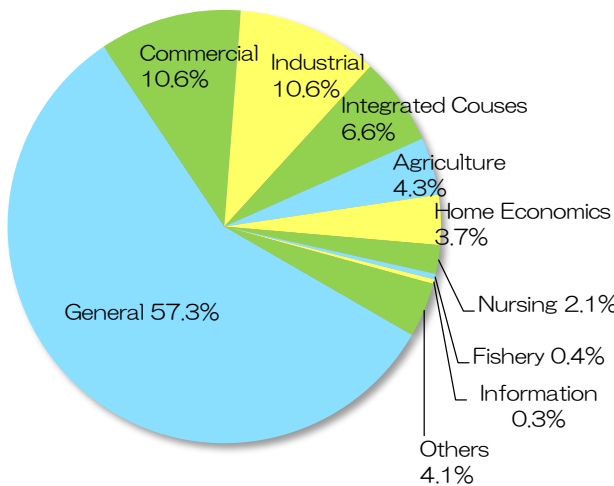
Changes of Enrollment Rate (National·Public·Private)

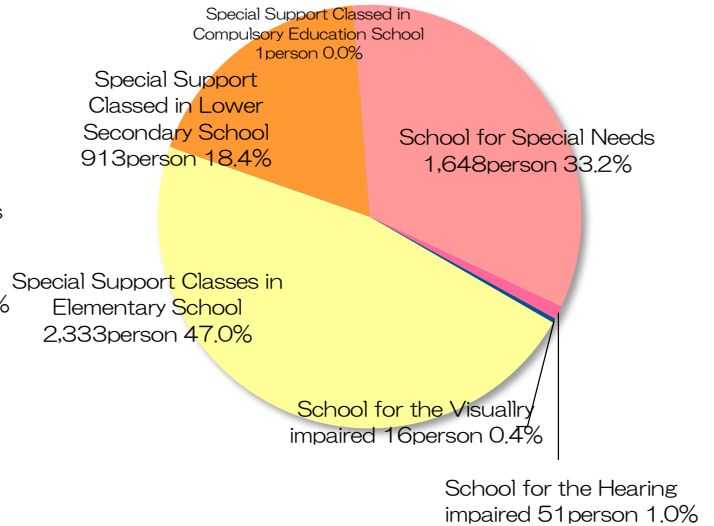

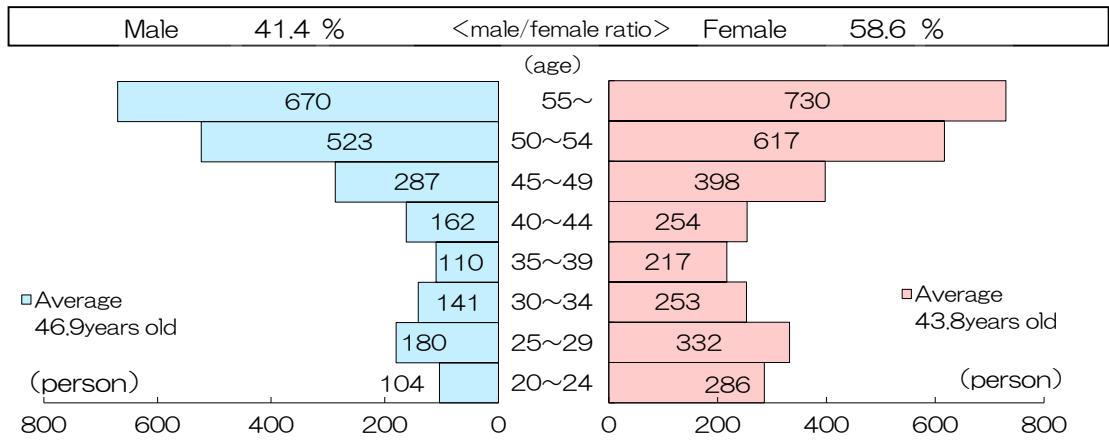

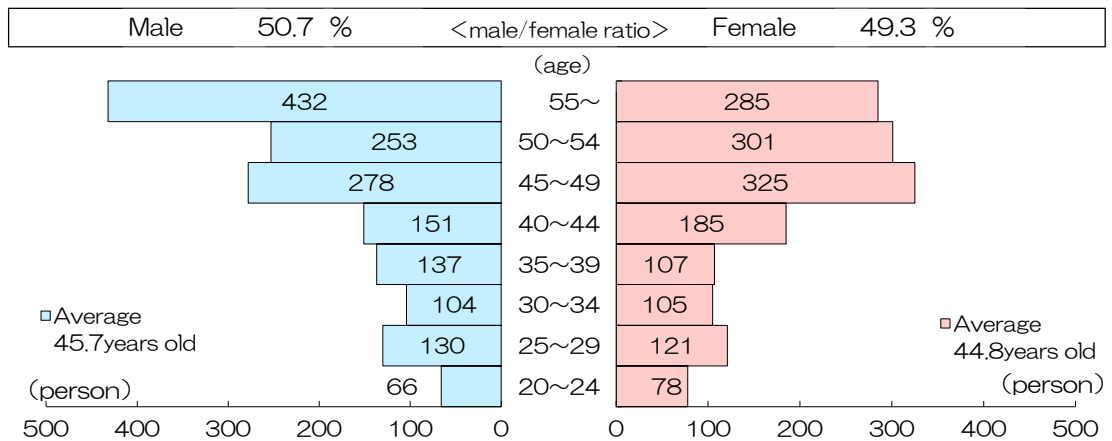
Number of Teachers, by Age

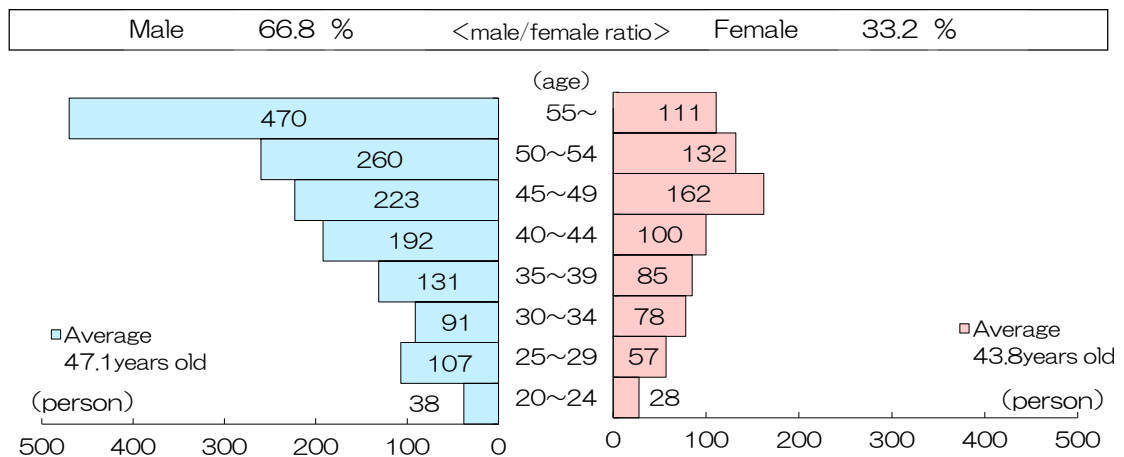

□ Lower Secondary School



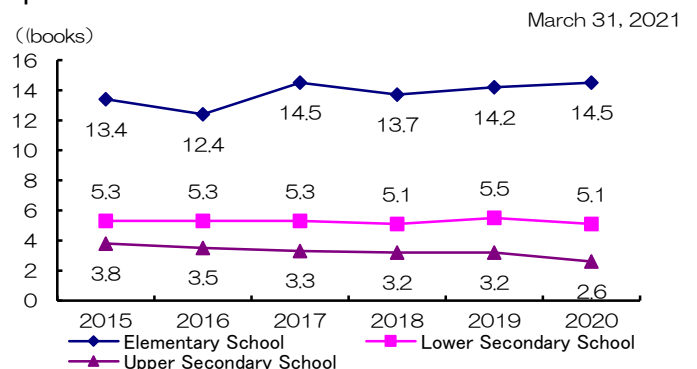

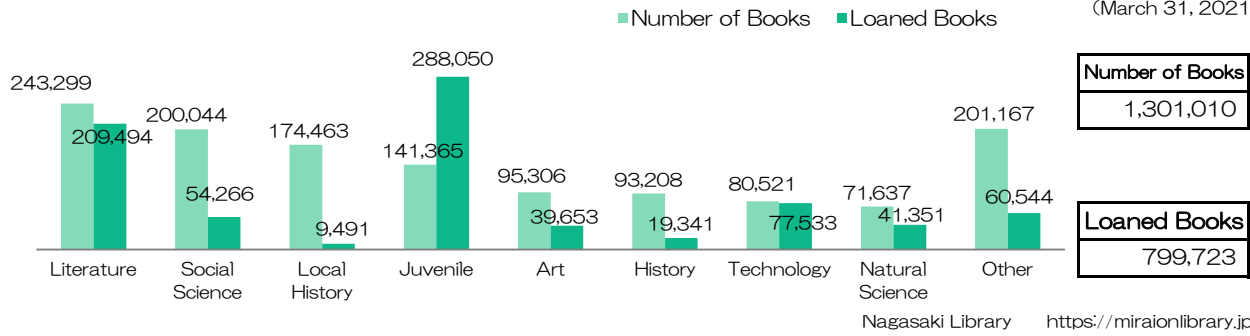

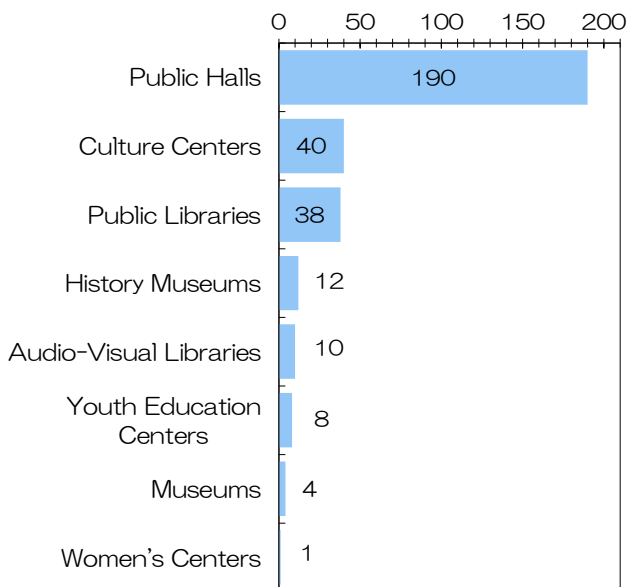
Total Numbers of Volumes and Loan Statistics in The Prefectural Library

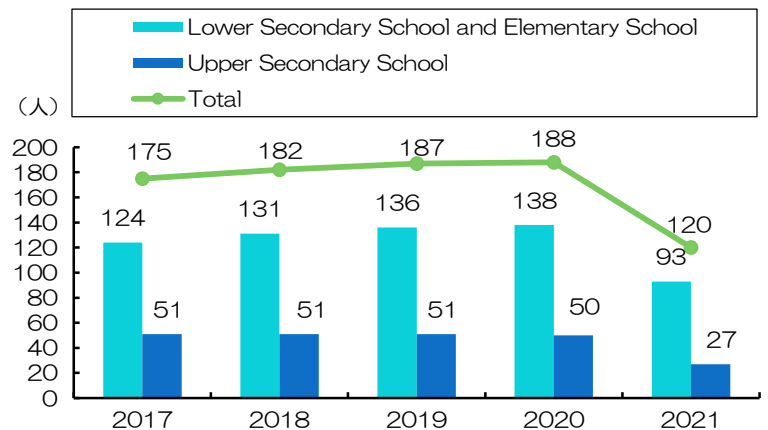

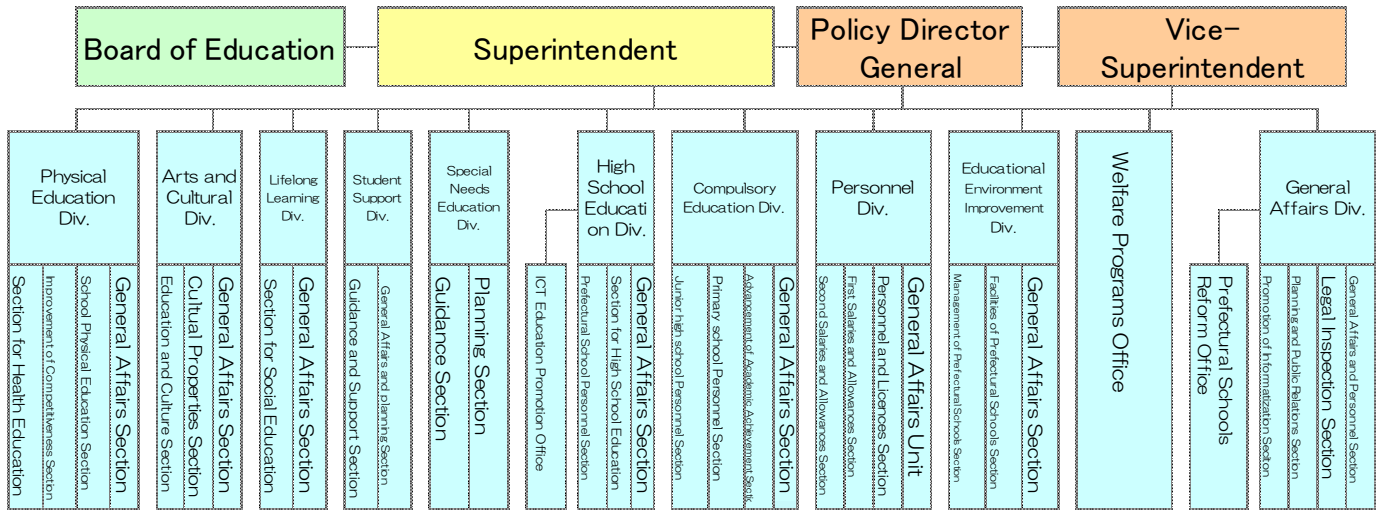
