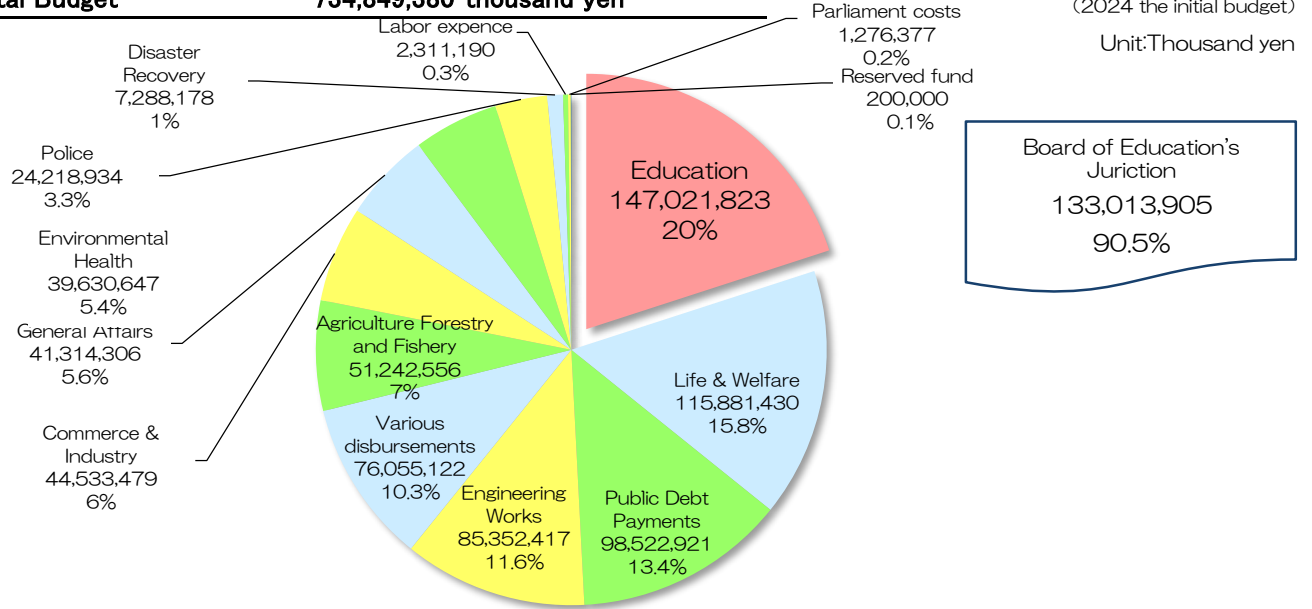

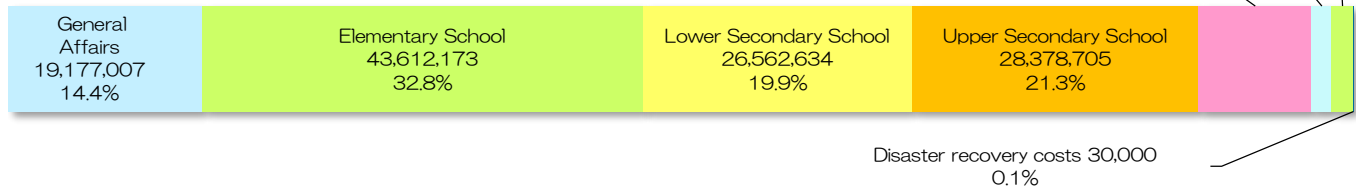

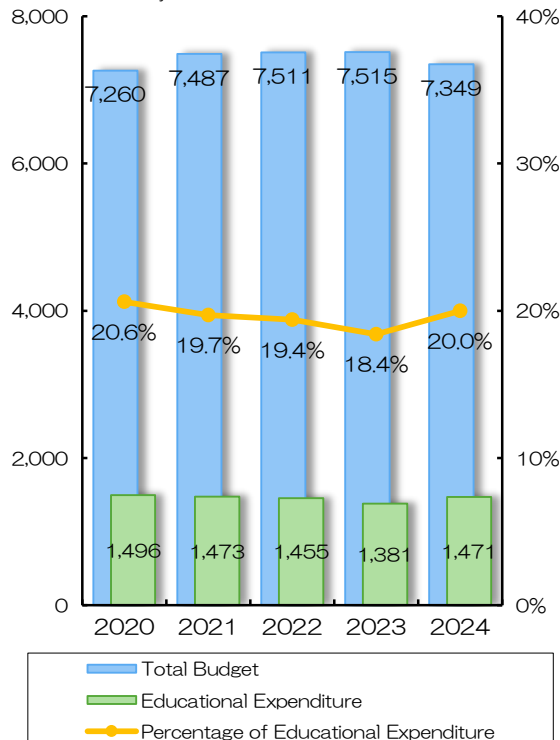

Unit: hundred million yen

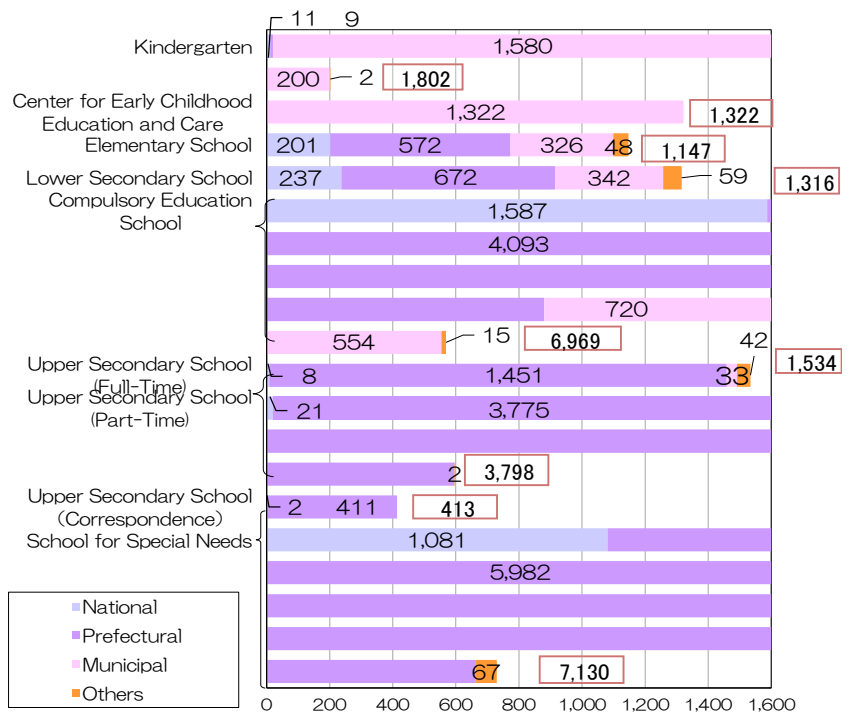


Educational Expenditure Per Student

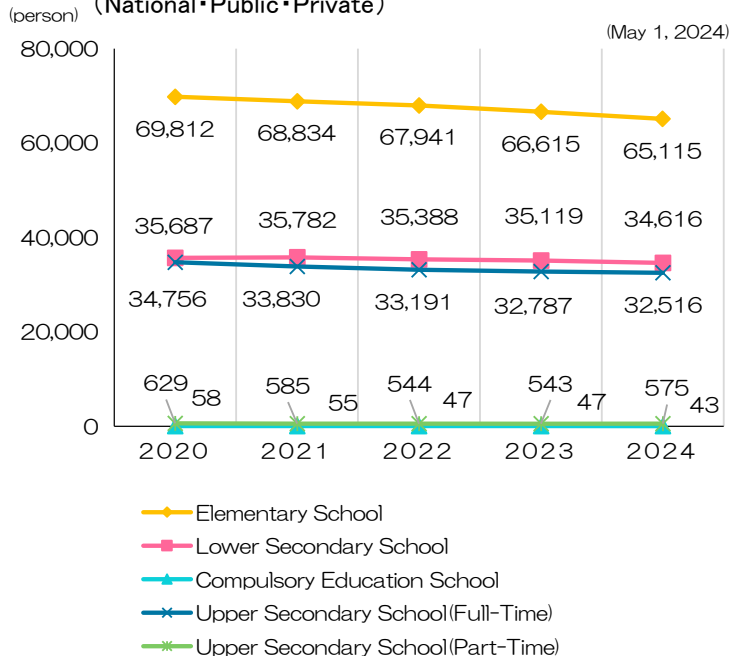

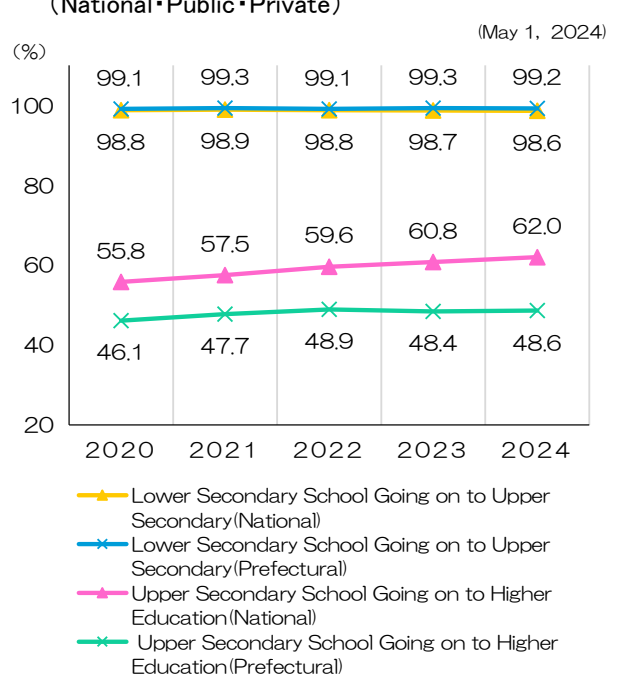

Changes in the Number of Students (National・Public・Private)



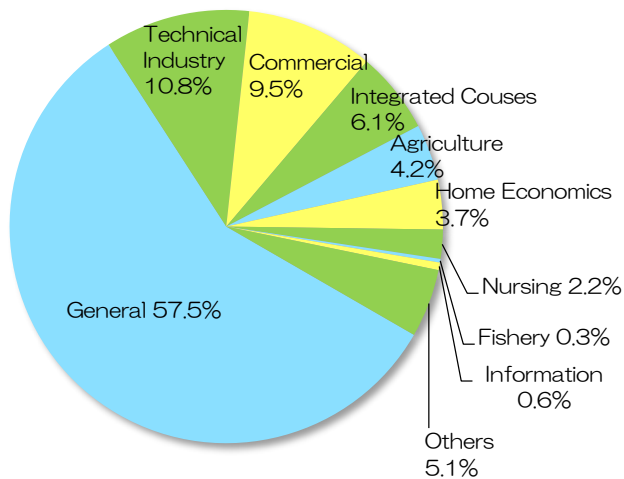
Changes of Enrollment Rate (National・Public・Private)

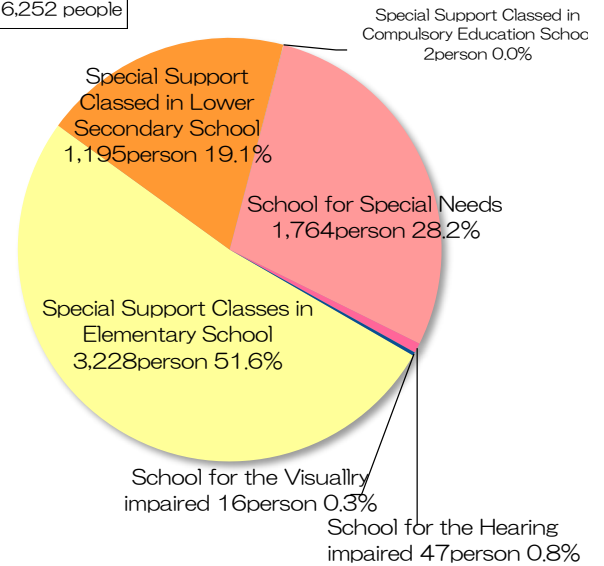

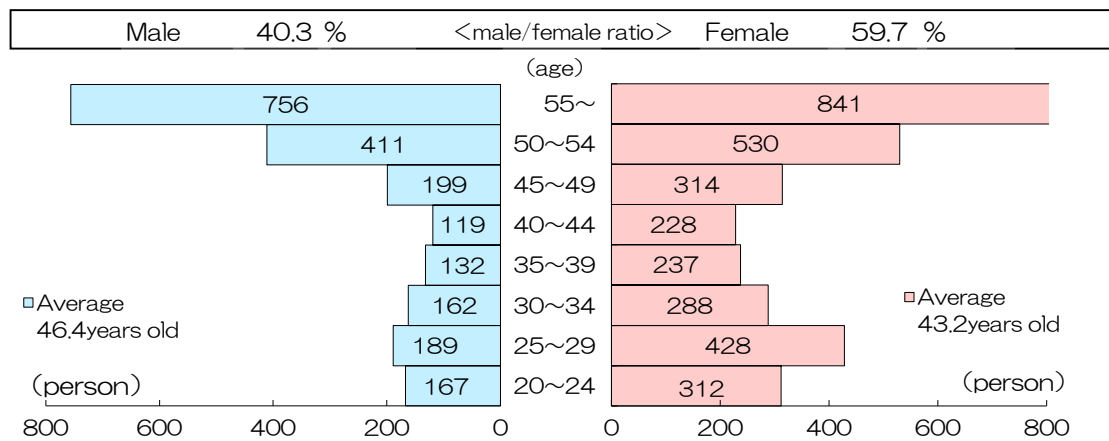

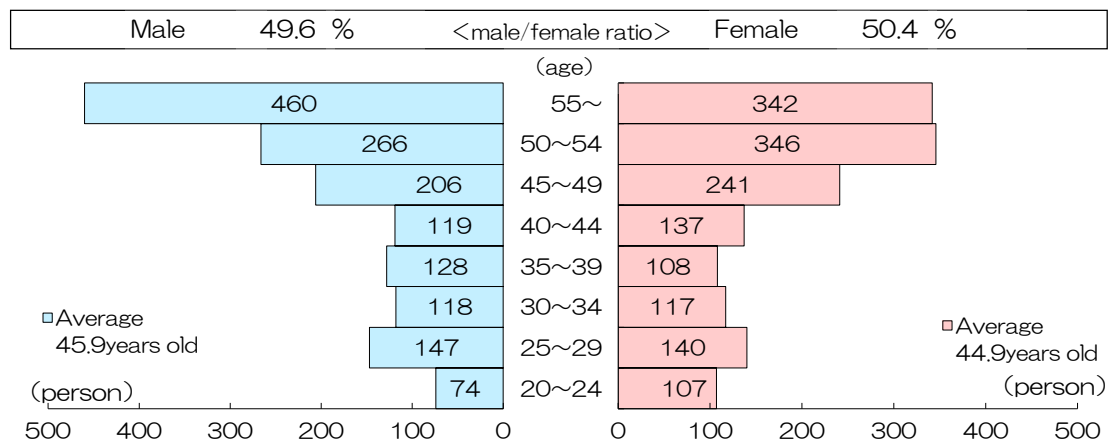
Number of Teachers, by Age

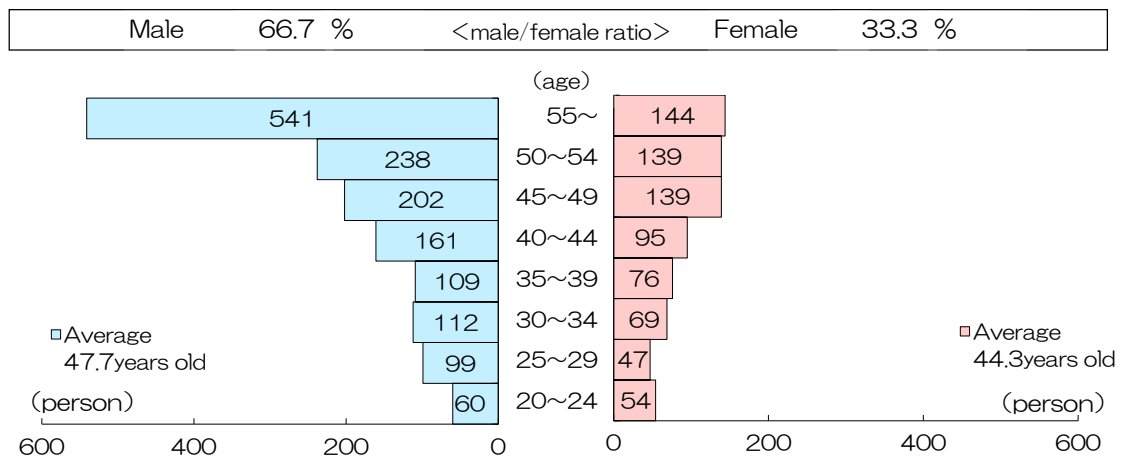

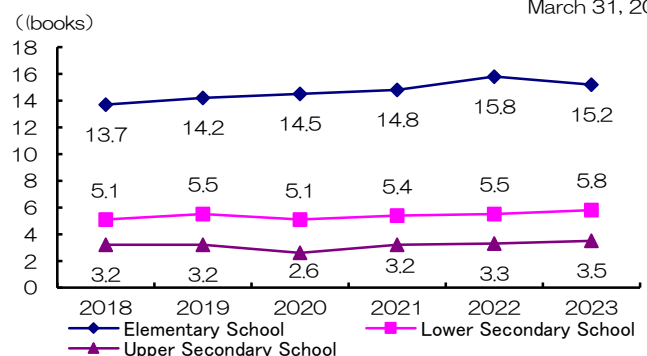

March 31, 2024



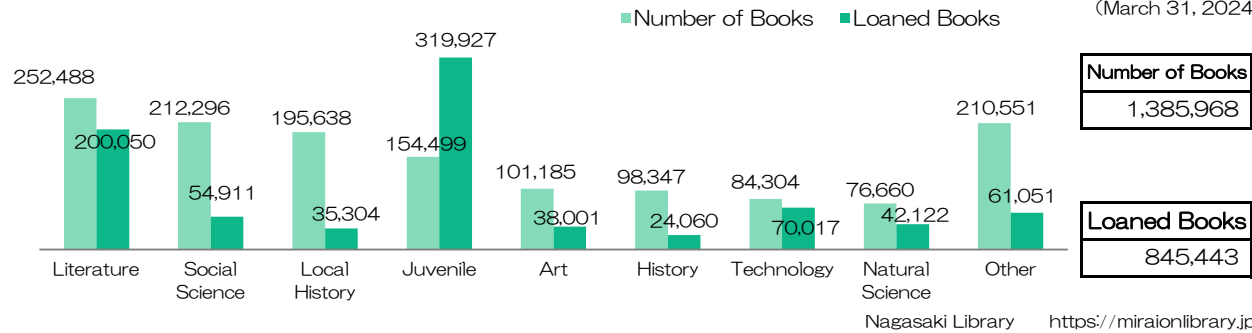

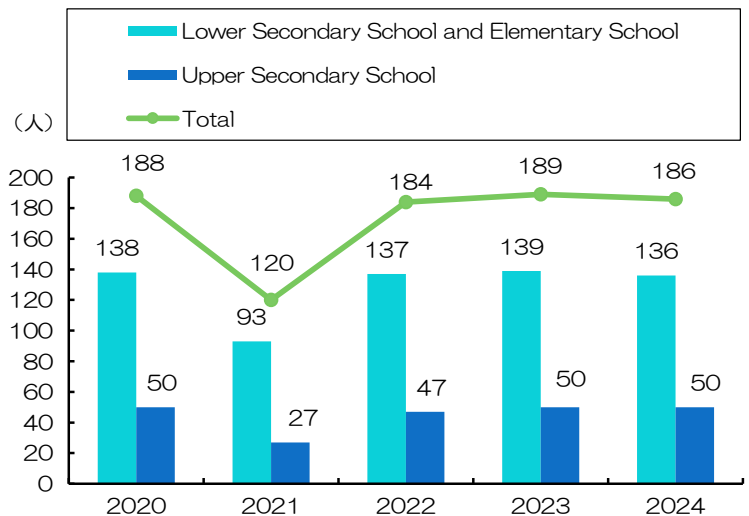

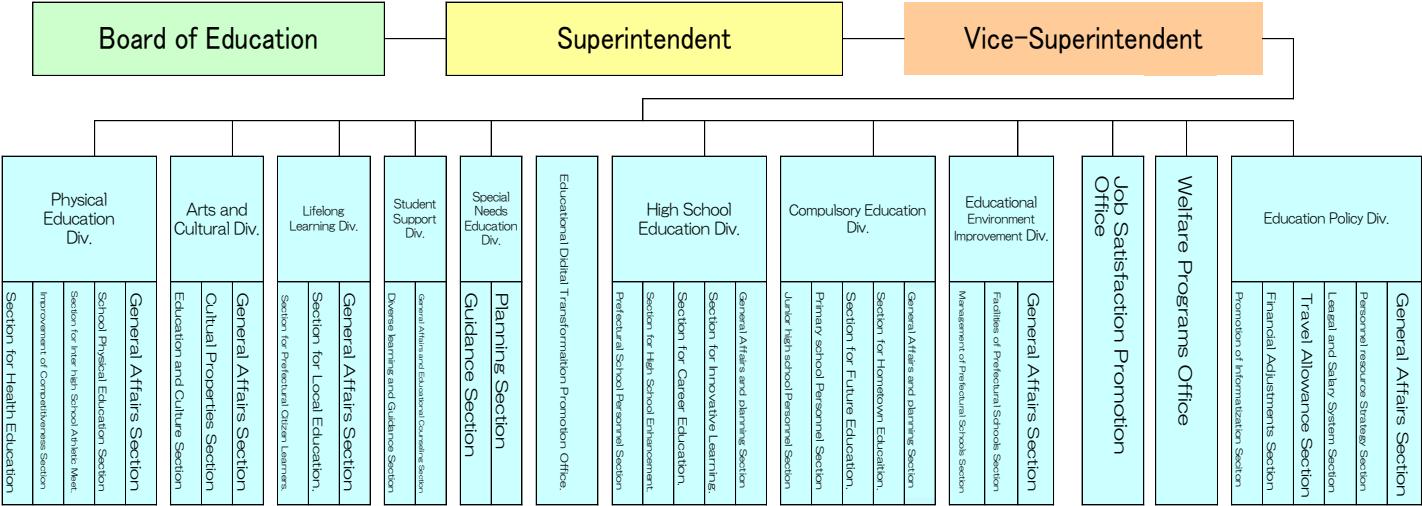
