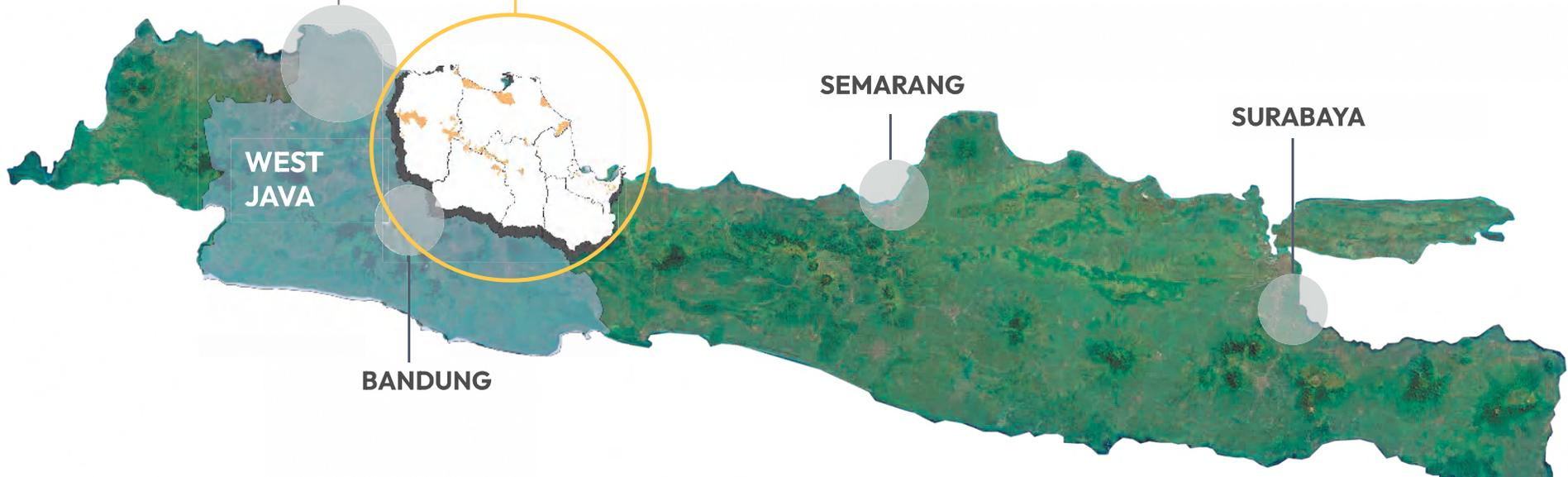

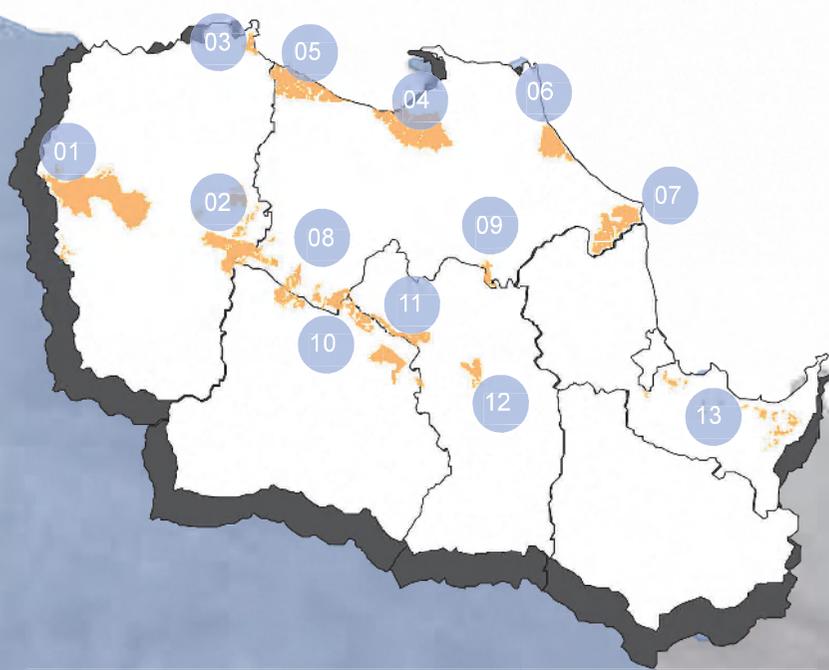

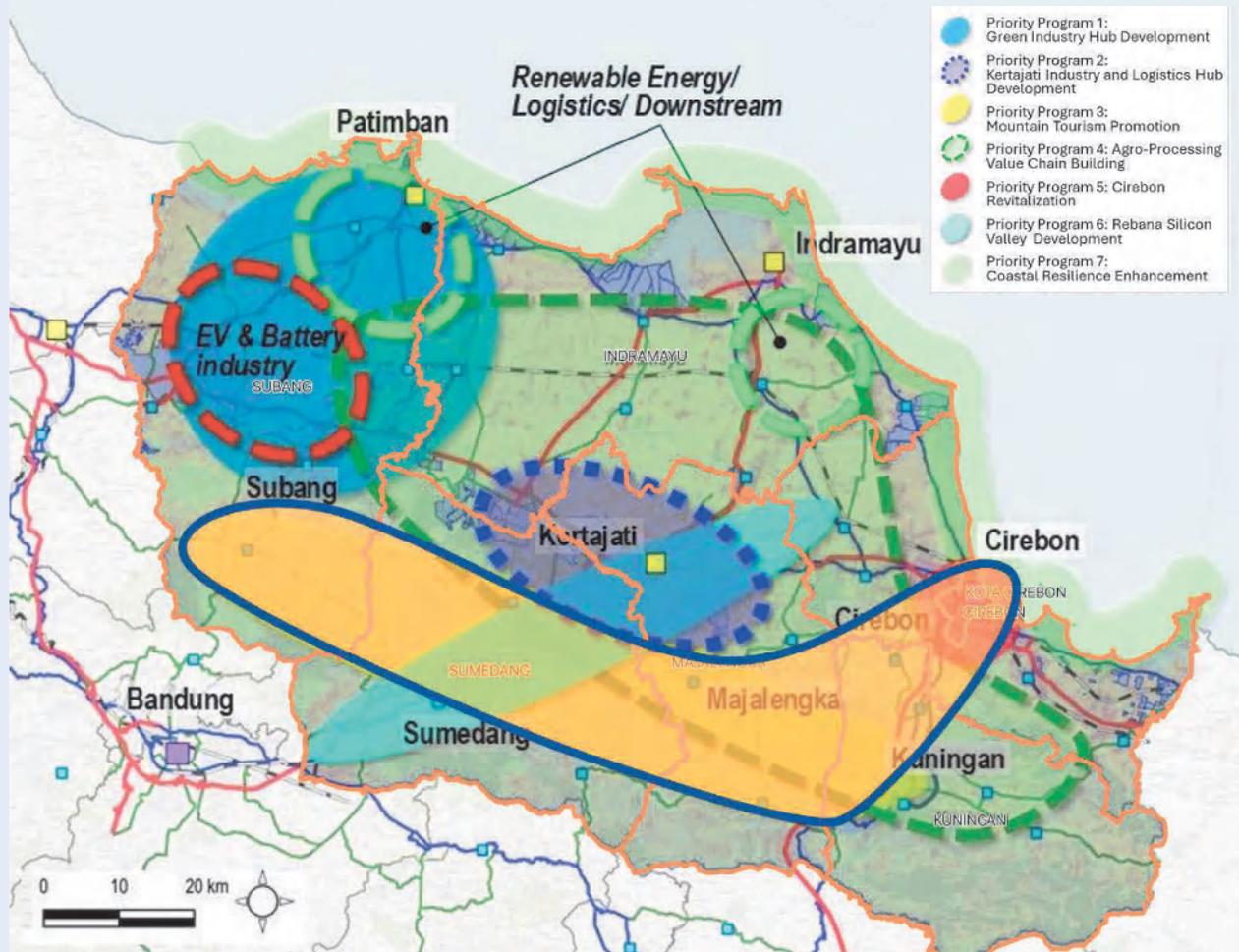
**8 out of 13 KPI** within Rebana sare already under development. There are **14 developers** currently developing **8,438 hectares** of New Industry-Based Cities.

# Flagship Corridor as the Foundation for Rebana's Development

Technical assistance from JICA for the preparation of the Master Plan is ongoing



JICA has provided support in developing the Rebana Regional Master Plan by formulating Priority Programs that align with the overall strategy for the Rebana Region.

## Priority Programs

1. Green Industry Hub Development Program, including Patimban New City
2. Kertajati Industry and Logistics Hub Development Program, including Kertajati Aero City
3. Mountain Tourism Promotion Program in the Rebana Region (Kuningan–Sumedang Highlands)
4. Agro-processing Value Chain Development Program in the Rebana Region (including Indramayu and Cirebon Regency)
5. Cirebon City Revitalization Program
6. Rebana Silicon Valley Development Program – Research and Development Center (Sumedang, Majalengka, and Cirebon Regency)
7. Coastal Resilience Strengthening Program in the Rebana Region (Subang, Indramayu, Cirebon Regency, and Cirebon City)

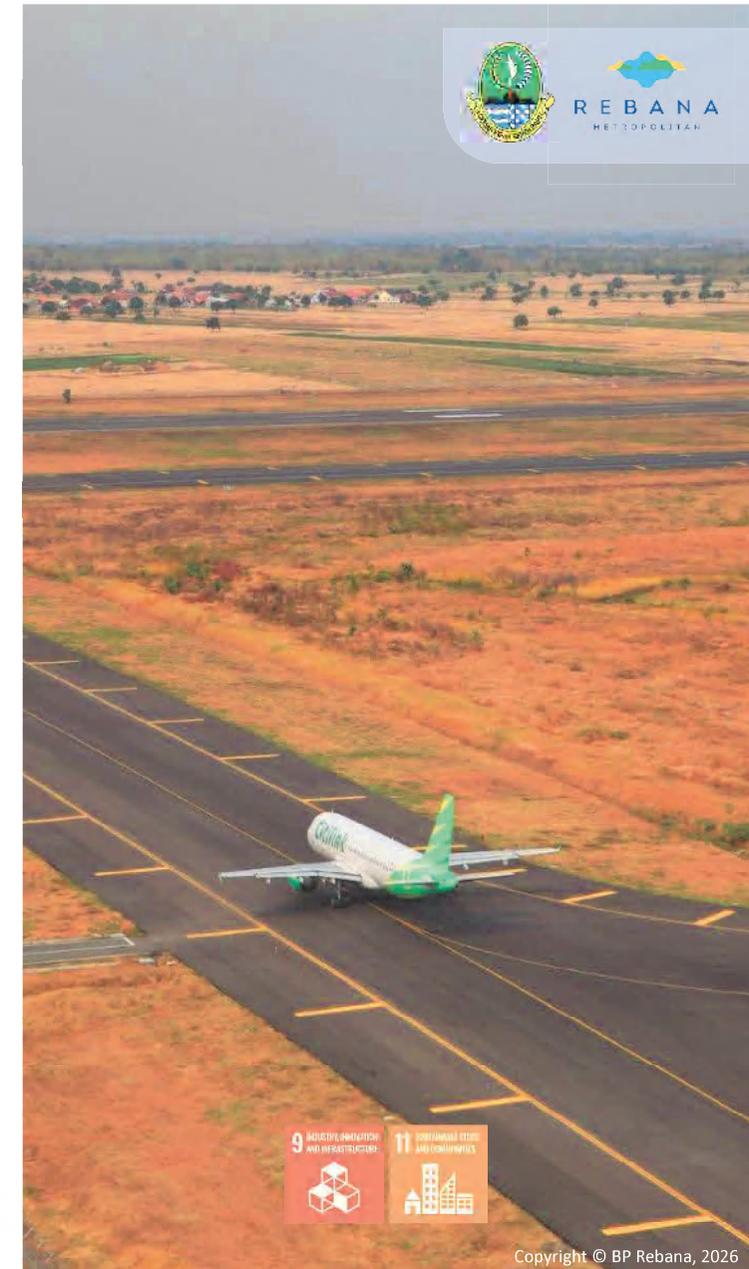
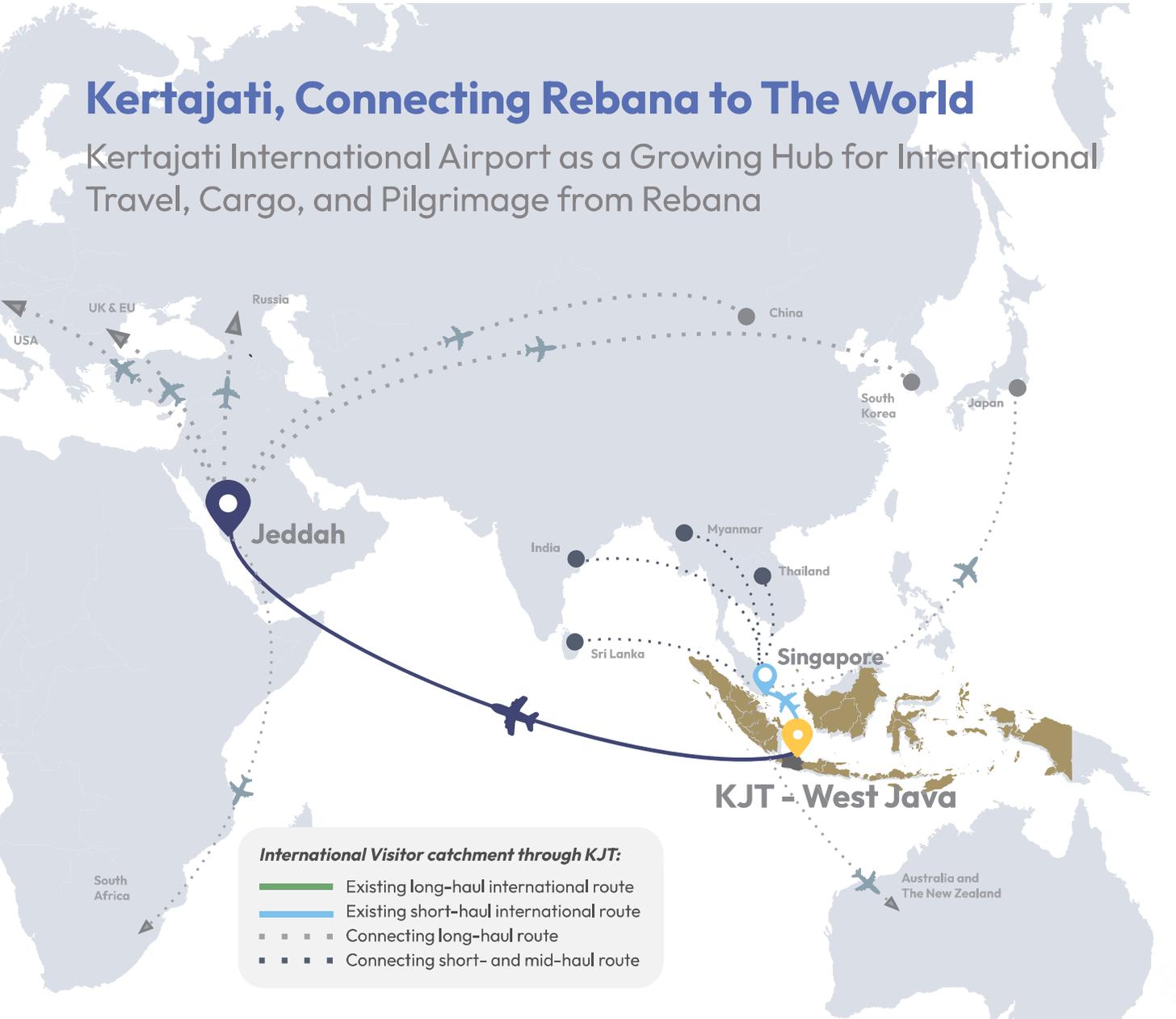

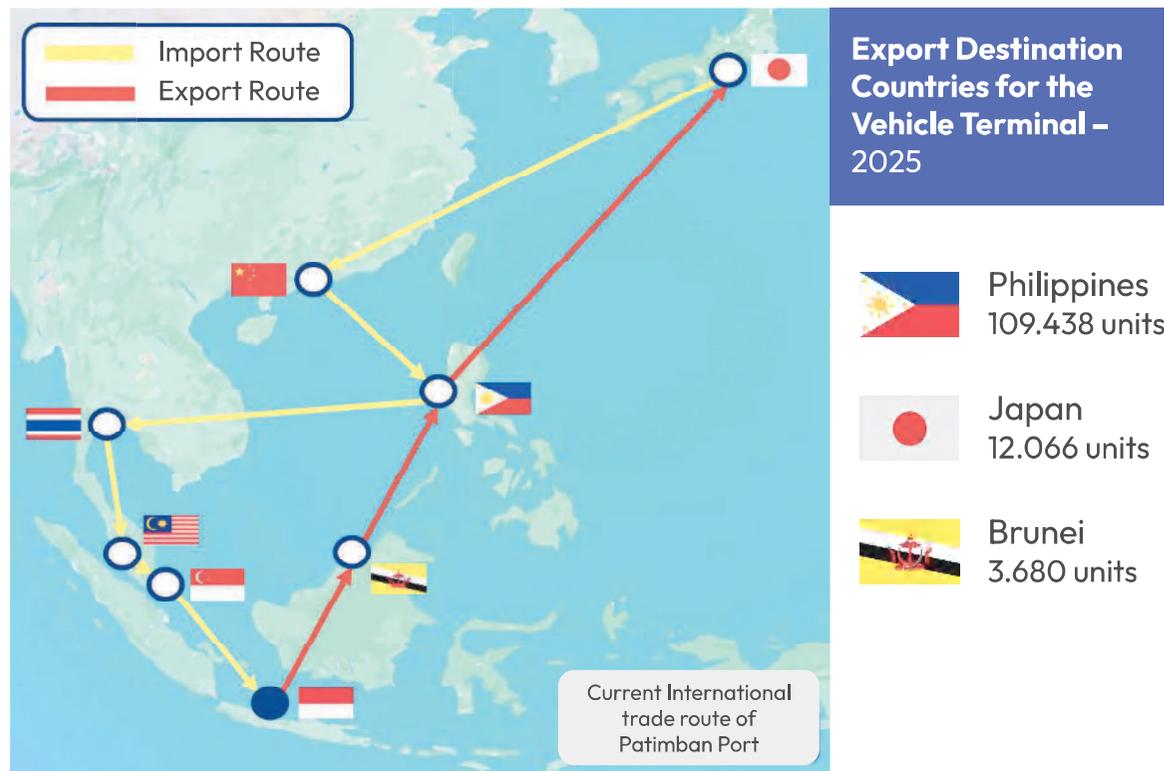

Expanding capacity and progressive supporting infrastructure development enhance connectivity and global supply chain integration.



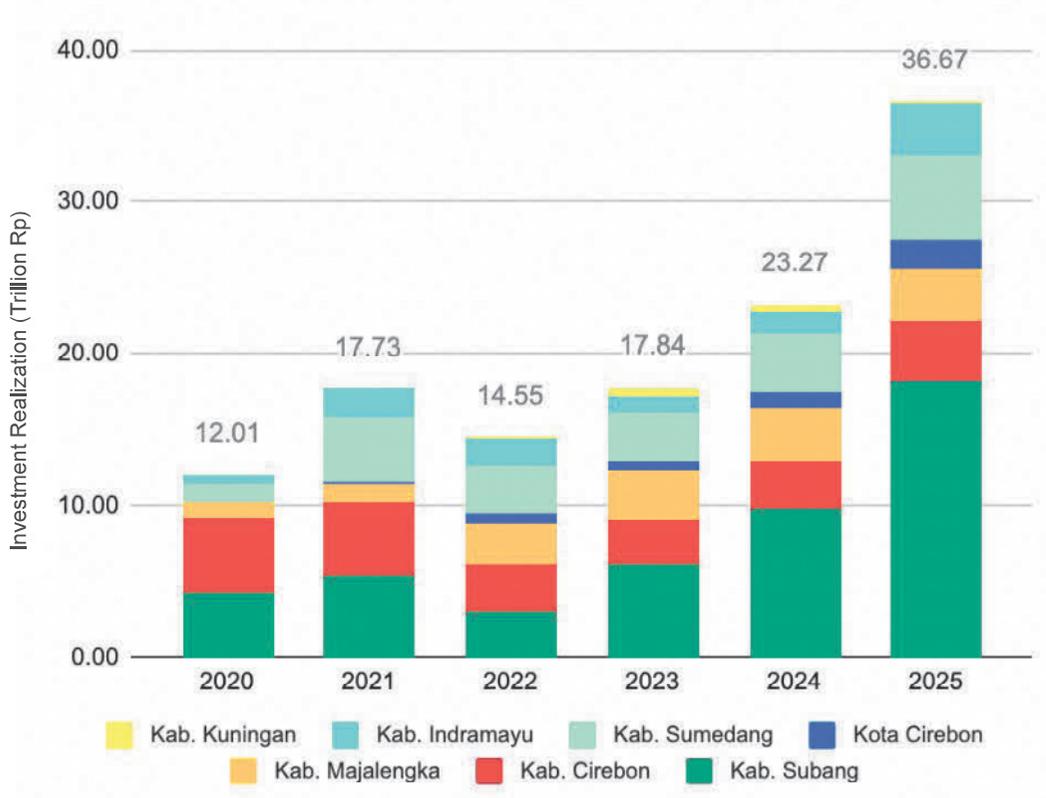

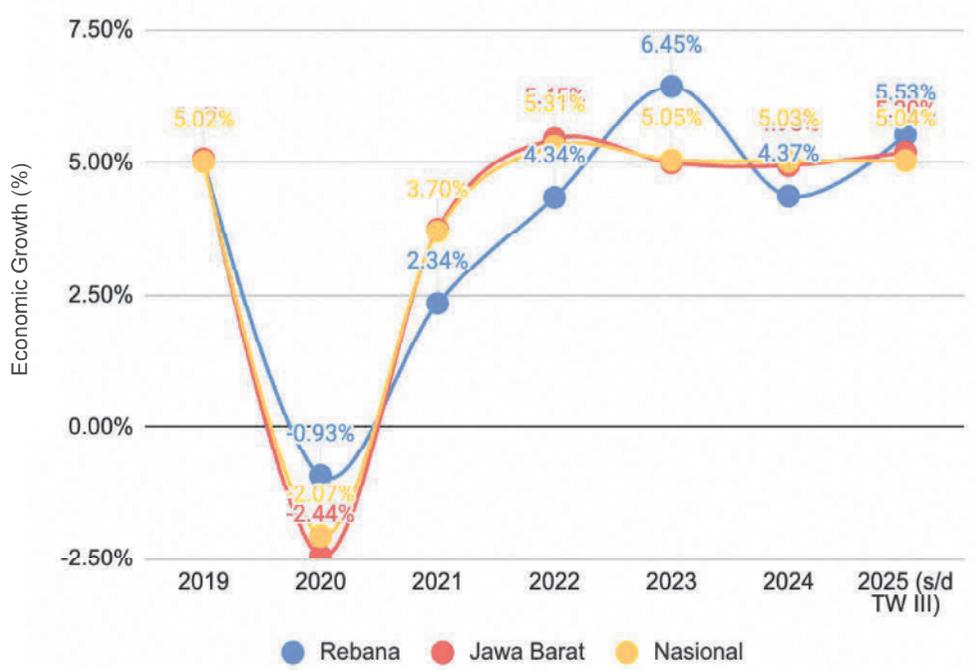

## Economic Growth

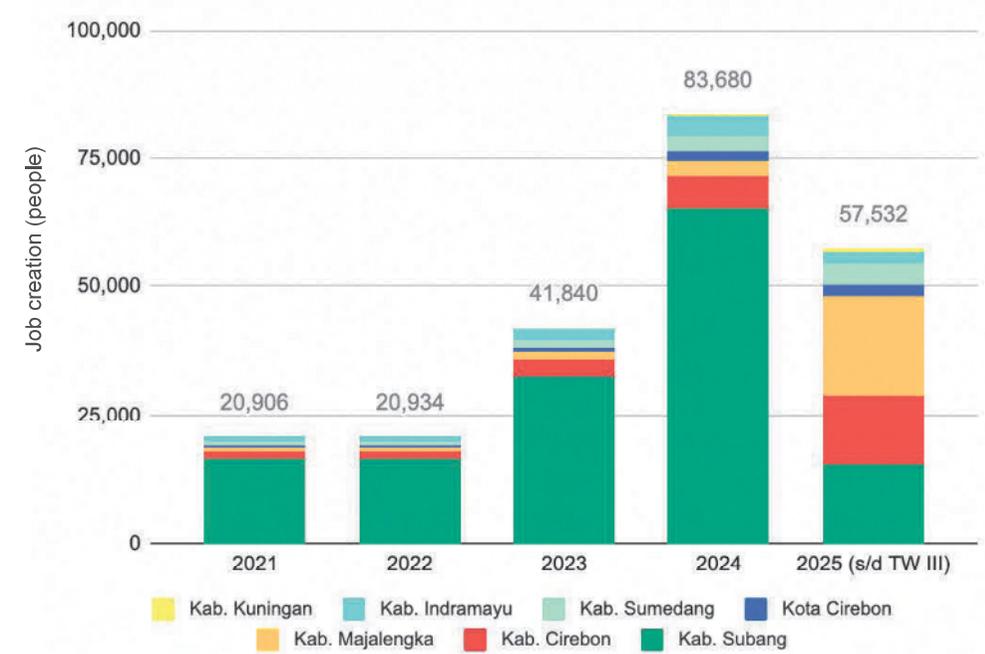
Rebana recorded **5.53%** year-on-year (y-o-y) economic growth in Q3 2025, outperforming both West Java and the national average.
